Terms of Use

The Online Accreditation System is a restricted access resource. At all times, you must:

- Use only the login credentials that IATA has assigned to you individually
- Take all necessary precautions to protect your login credentials
- Use the database in accordance with IATA's full terms of use (http://www.iata.org/Pages/terms.aspx)

The Online Accreditation System gives control and responsibility to Head Delegates (HODs) to add, remove and edit the details of their accredited delegates. It is each HOD's responsibility to keep their delegation's details up to date.

How we use your data

- IATA holds the data of Head Delegates for the purpose of informing them on the following matters: slot advocacy news and updates; Notices of Airport Level Changes (NOLC); Worldwide Airport Slot Guidelines (WASG) updates; and other slot related information that IATA Slots believe is beneficial and relevant for head delegates to conduct their work.
- HODs accredit their delegates to represent their organization at the Slot Conference and this information is held by IATA and passed to the Slot Conference event management company (currently McVeigh, based in the US) for the purposes of registering to attend the Slot Conference and for providing relevant information pertaining to the Slots Conference.

By providing information to IATA within the Online Accreditation System, users consent – to the extent consent is necessary under applicable law – that this information may be shared with the conference event company for the above purposes.

How to unsubscribe at any time.

- If accredited delegates no longer wish to receive information from the IATA Slots team (including but not limited to Slot Advocacy Updates, Notices of Airport Level Changes AND Worldwide Airport Slot Guidelines (WASG) updates) they should email slots@iata.org with "UNSUBSCRIBE TO IATA Slots Information" in the subject line. Kindly note this will apply to all future correspondence from IATA Slots.
- If accredited delegates no longer wish to receive information from the event company (currently McVeigh, based in the US, formerly known as WorldTEK), they should unsubscribe using the links found on the bottom of 'IATA Events' communications and follow the instructions. Kindly note this will apply to all future correspondence including registration confirmation emails and invitations to register for future conferences.
