The Simplified Interline Settlement (SIS) project aims to simplify interline billing, and remove paper from the entire process, delivering tangible financial benefits to the industry.

As announced previously, SIS has begun moving forward with the implementation of the Integrated Settlement solution. One major step is the release of the [Basics for Airline Internal Business Case](#) document.

The document, now updated in the [Materials](#) section of the website, provides further details about the SIS solution, the various processes to be supported, and how the migration is expected to occur. Additionally, it helps carriers identify potential benefits and cost reductions. It has been updated with the expected IS fees.
