انفلونزا الخنازير

مرض يسببه فيروس انفلونزا A (H1N1) يصيب الجهاز التنفسي في الخنازير وأدى الى حدوث اوبئة متكررة في السنوات الأخيرة في الخنازير وحالياً (نيسان ٢٠٠٩) تم التبليغ عن انتقاله من إنسان الى آخر في مناطق مختلفة من العالم مع ارتفاع في أعداد الإصابات البشرية وحدثت بعض الوفيات نتيجة الإصابة بانفلونزا الخنازير.

طرق الإنتقال :

- ✳ ينتقل من شخص لآخر عن طريق التنفس للسعال والعطس من أشخاص مصابين .
- ✳ ملامسة الأدوات والأسطح الملوثة بالبرذاذ الناتج عن العطس أو السعال من الأشخاص المصابين .
- ✳ التعامل المباشر مع الخنازير المصابة .

الأعراض في الإنسان :

- ✳ ارتفاع في درجة حرارة الجسم
- ✳ سعال
- ✳ ألم في العضلات
- ✳ قشعريرة
- ✳ سيلان في الأنف
- ✳ احتقان في الحلق
- ✳ اسهال وقيء وغثيان

فترة العدوى:

يكون الشخص المصاب معدياً قبل يوم من ظهور الأعراض وتستمر العدوى لمدة سبعة أيام بعد ظهور الأعراض .

لتجنب الإصابة بالمرض :

- ✳ غسل الأيدي بالماء والصابون وخاصة بعد السعال والعطس .
- ✳ تغطية الأنف والضمم بمنديل ورقي عند العطس أو السعال وإلقائه فوراً في سلة المهملات .
- ✳ **تجنب مخالطة الأشخاص المصابين** أو المشابهة بأصابتهم بالأنفلونزا .
- ✳ تجنب ملامسة العيون والأنف .
- ✳ تجنب الأماكن المزدحمة .
- ✳ الابتعاد عن الأماكن التي تربي فيها الخنازير .

ماذا يجب عليك فعله عندما تظهر عليك أعراض شبيهة بالأنفلونزا ؟

إذا كنت متواجداً أو قادماً من منطقة تم فيها الإعلان عن إصابات بين البشر بانفلونزا الخنازير أو إصابات بين الخنازير وظهرت لديك أي من الأعراض التالية :

ارتفاع بالحرارة - سعال - الالام بالجسم - سيلان أنف - ألم بالحلق - غثيان أو اسهال أو قيء
راجع أقرب مركز صحي لديك ، أو استشر أقرب طبيب في منطقتك ليقوم بالاجراءات المناسبة .

**Swine Flue:**

A disease caused by the A(H1N1) virus. It affects the respiratory system in pigs. In April 2009 it was reported that outbreaks in humans are now occurring from human-to-human transmission.

How do people become infected with influenza A(H1N1):

- When infected people cough or sneeze
- Being in direct contact with contaminated surface.
- Being in direct contact with pigs

Signs and symptoms of infection:

- Fever
- Cough
- Muscle and joint pain
- Runny nose,
- Sore throat
- Vomiting or diarrhea.

Period of contamination:

A day before symptoms start to appear. Contamination lasts for 7 days.

Prevention measures:

- Wash your hands with soap and water thoroughly and often especially after coughing or sneezing
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue while coughing or sneezing and get throw tissue in the bin immediately
- Avoid close contact with people who appear unwell and have fever and cough;
- Avoid touching the eyes and nose
- Avoid crowded places
- Avoid areas that breed pigs

What should you do if you develop flu like symptoms?

- If you are already in an area or coming from an area where there have been reported cases of A(H1N1), and have developed the following symptoms: fever, cough, muscle and joint pain, runny nose, sore throat, vomiting or diarrhea, go to the nearest healthcare center or the nearest doctor so that they will take care the necessary measures.

The information you provide will assist the public health authorities to manage the public health event by enabling them to trace passengers who may have been exposed to communicable disease.
