Cuban Institute of Civil Aviation Informational Note

THE Cuban Institute of Civil Aviation, exercising its authority under the law with respect to the international aviation community, and considering the measures adopted by the National General Staff of the Civil Defense, decreeing the alert phase given the swine flu situation and actions ordered by the national Public Health authorities, establishes:

1. To temporarily suspend regular and charter flights operating between Cuba and Mexico as of 24:00 hours on April 29, 2009. As of that date, airlines will be permitted to make flights to pick up their passengers in Cuba who are traveling to Mexico.
2. All passengers who arrive in the country from any destination are to fill out a Traveler's Health Declaration form.

The Aviation Authorities will communicate the decision to the Cuban state, with respect to measures taken in relation to the International Organization of Civil Aviation.

Once the causes that have motivated these decisions have ceased, air operations will be reestablished, with interested parties being duly informed.
