

## **News Bulletins IATA Nordic & Baltic 2007 January - June**

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### **2007/06/01 - Issuing E-ticket, if possible, is default from 1st June 2007**

One of the major initiatives in the Simplifying the Business Project (StB) is implementation of 100% electronic ticketing from 1st January 2008. In preparation for the deadline of all paper tickets all tickets issued after 1st June 2007 must be issued as e-tickets where the city pair allows e-ticket. This is implemented as an amendment in resolution 722. The passenger cannot choose or the travel agent is not allowed to issue paper ticket in these cases.

### **2007/04/27 - Recall of MPDs and CIPs**

Manual MPDs are no longer in use in BSP Nordic & Baltic. All MPDs and Carrier Identification Plates (CIPs) have been recalled from the Travel Agents with effective date 30th April 2007. ### **2007/04/20 - Update on Swefly - Reconstruction failed**

IATA has received information that the reconstruction of Swefly has failed due to lack of financial funding. The reconstructor therefore concluded that a regular bankruptcy was the unavoidable next step. The District Court has consequently declared Swefly in bankruptcy and appointed the advokat, Mr. Brännström, as the receiver. IATA has provided the receiver with information available to IATA regarding i.a. passenger tickets, to facilitate the work of the receiver. IATA will continue to monitor progress. However, the management and resolution of any legal issues now rests primarily with the receiver.

### **2007/04/17 - Remittance period 2 March 2007**

### **2007/04/16 - Credit Card Transactions for Airlines in period 01APR**

For Airlines participating in BSP Nordic & Baltic, please be informed that the daily credit card files processed in the beginning of April can show a low amount of credit card transactions. The reason for this was due to a missing file from one ticketing system 3rd April. This was rectified and all files run on the 10th April meaning that daily credit card files from the 10th or 11th April should contain all these transactions.

**2007/04/03 - LAB Airlines (Lloyd aero Boliviano) (LB-051) in Suspension**

Referring to Resolution 850f, please be advised that the Carrier LAB Airlines (LB-051) has been put into suspension by IATA until further notice. This means that Ticketing and Refunding is closed with immediate effect in DK, NO and SE. IATA is holding all funds for the Airline in question. BSP Remittances for Agents should be completed in full and IATA will initiate discussions with the official liquidator when such has been assigned.
