

Terms and Conditions of IATA Clearing House Membership

Sponsored Members: An air carrier, or air carrier Subsidiary, sponsored by an IATA Member that is a Member of the Clearing House, (a) whose revenue accounting functions are performed by that IATA Member; (b) whose claims (both by and against such carrier or Subsidiary) under the Regulations are the responsibility of that IATA Member as further set out at Regulation 4(c); and (c) which has not been suspended or terminated in accordance with these Regulations, unless it has met the obligations for which it was terminated or suspended.

ICH Manual, Part A, Regulation 4 (c)

Membership in the Clearing House is open to Sponsored Members subject to the following conditions:

- (i) Interline transactions of the Sponsored Member must be included in the Billings of the sponsoring IATA Member of the Clearing House;
- (ii) Any Security Deposit that may be assessed upon the Sponsored Member in accordance with these Regulations must be provided by the Sponsoring Member prior to the inclusion of the Sponsored Member transactions;
- (iii) Billings for all categories of Sponsored Member transactions must be included in the sponsoring IATA Member's claim, and the sponsoring IATA Member must accept all categories of transactions claimed by other Members, unless an express written agreement to exclude transactions from Clearance has been made between the sponsoring IATA Member and the other Clearing House Member concerned:
- (iv) by written notice to the Clearing House Manager, a Member may object to the transactions of a Sponsored Member being cleared and, in that case, the sponsoring IATA Member shall cease to include the transactions of the Sponsored Member in the claim against the objecting Member on receiving notice from the Clearing House;
- (v) sponsoring IATA Members shall be assessed a special service fee in accordance with Regulation 40 (b) for each non-IATA entity sponsored;
- (vi) the sponsoring IATA Member is liable to the Clearing House for payment in respect of the Sponsored Member's transactions as if they were the transactions of the sponsoring IATA Member; and
- (vii) the Clearing House Manager shall consider applications for sponsorship received from IATA Members of the Clearing House, any such application to be approved if it is in conformity with the conditions set out at this Regulation 4 (c),

and those conditions as established from time to time by the Financial Committee.

Annual Membership Service Charges and Fees

Service fees will be assessed against Sponsored Members that are not IATA Members as outlined in ICH Procedure 11(a)(ii).
