09:50 – 10:30 **UN Aviation Security Resolution: From Global Policy Making To Operational Reality**

In September 2016, the UN Security Council issued the Resolution 2309 (2016) focusing on Aviation Security. It recognizes the vital importance of the aviation system for the global economy and calls upon the ICAO Member States to ensure that security standards are continuously reviewed and implemented to adapt effectively to threats perpetuated by terrorists. States and organizations are requested to assist each-others in delivery of capacity building, strengthen security screening procedures and promote innovation in technologies and techniques to maximize the capability to detect security threats. This is a unique window for opportunity to reshape the global cargo security agenda and make an impact on the future governance of aviation security.
