TACT Data Rules contain general industry rules information, country import and export regulations and carrier rules of transportation. TACT Data Rules can be supplied in three different formats, MIF, XML or PDF, and can be easily integrated within your corporate network. This allows end-users to work with tailor-made information in their own environment.

TACT Data Rates is a database in carriage return and line feed (CRLF) and ASCII extract format. It contains air cargo rates and charges, which can be implemented in a variety of ways.

Depending on users' needs, the data can be purchased as follows:

- Worldwide rates (from all origins to all destinations worldwide export/import)
- Rates to and from one country (i.e. Italy to worldwide and from worldwide to Italy export/import)
- Rates from country to worldwide (i.e. from Germany to worldwide export)
