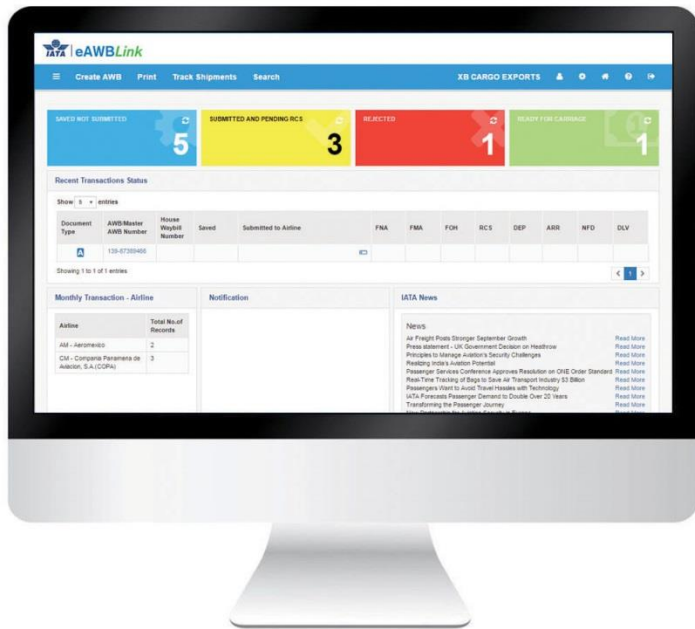

e-AWB tool for Freight Forwarders

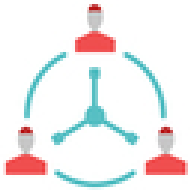


- eAWBLink is a web-based tool designed for small and medium forwarders to do e-AWB.
- Forwarders can use the tool to capture and transmit shipment data (AWB, HAWB, e-CSD) to Airline partners by using IATA standard messages, and receive shipment status updates electronically.
- The goal of eAWBLink is to enable forwarders to switch to e-AWB and join the e-Cargo community!

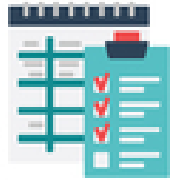

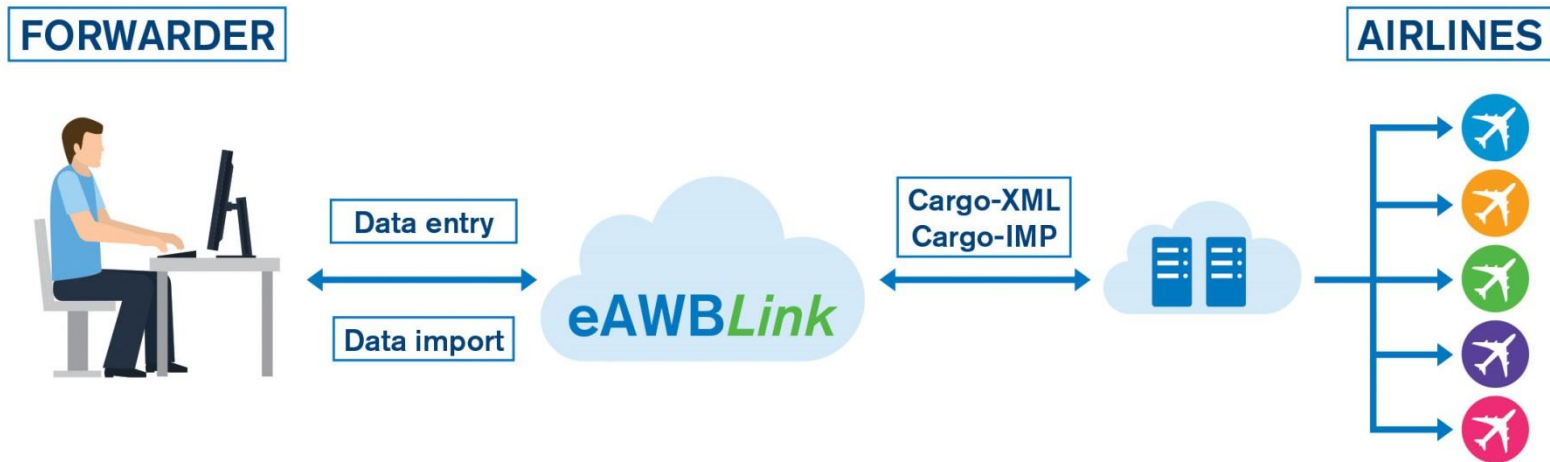
