

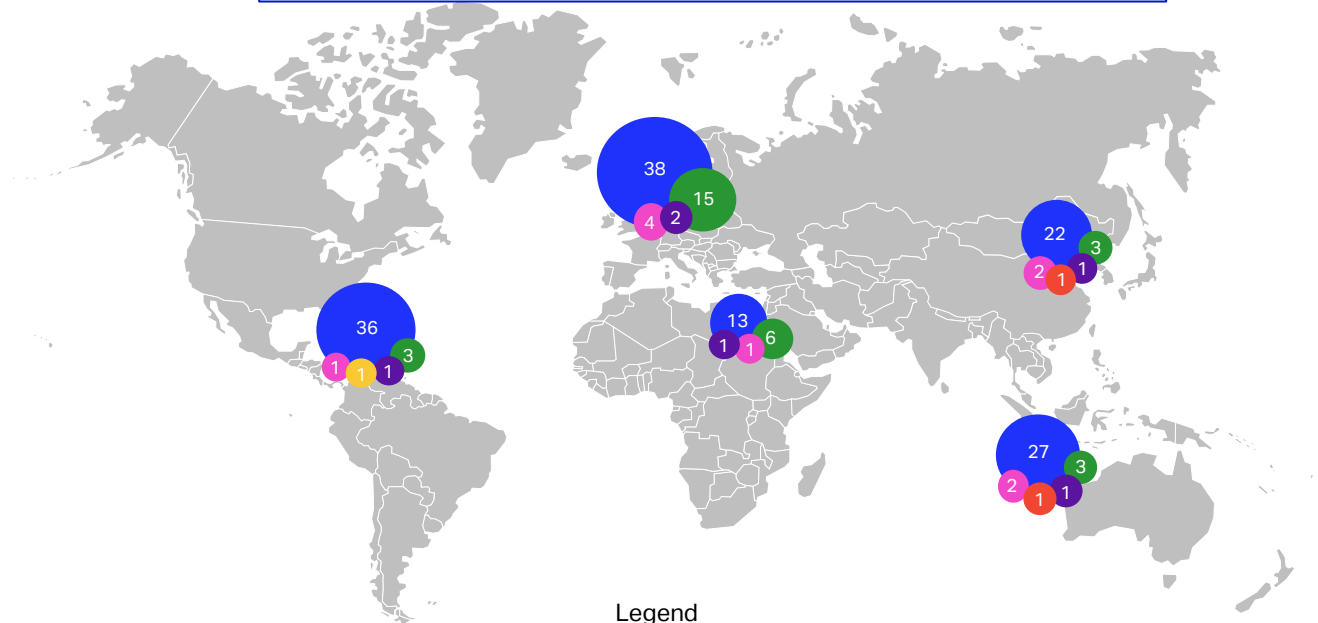

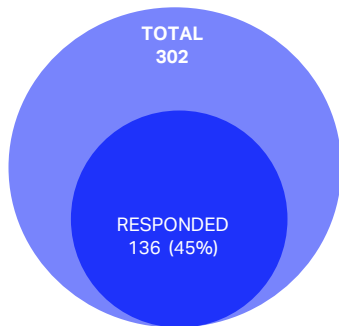

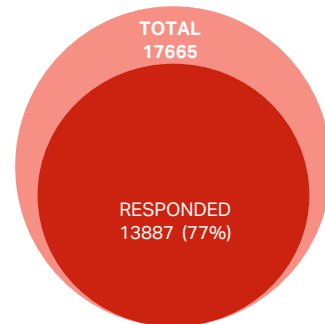

By IATA airline fleet, # of aircraft (narrowbody, widebody, regional jet)



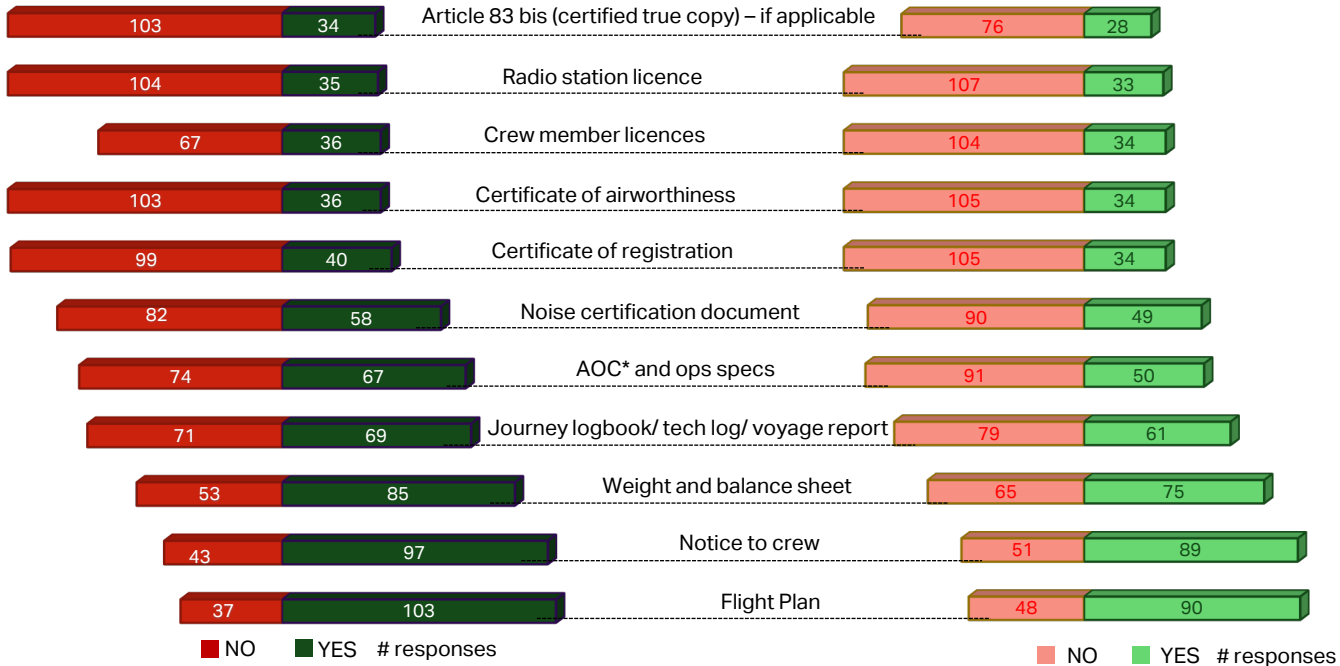

We carry the following documents on board of the aircraft in electronic format at least on one or more fleets

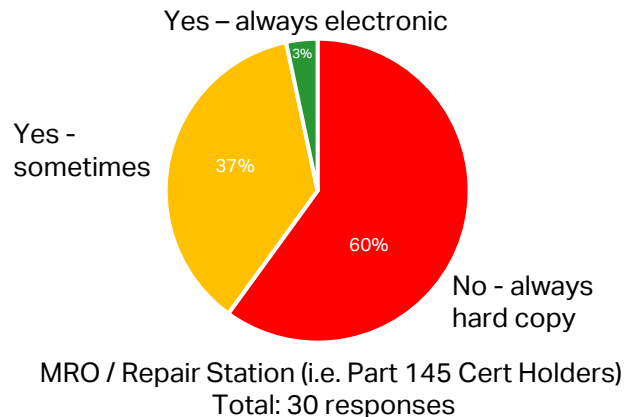
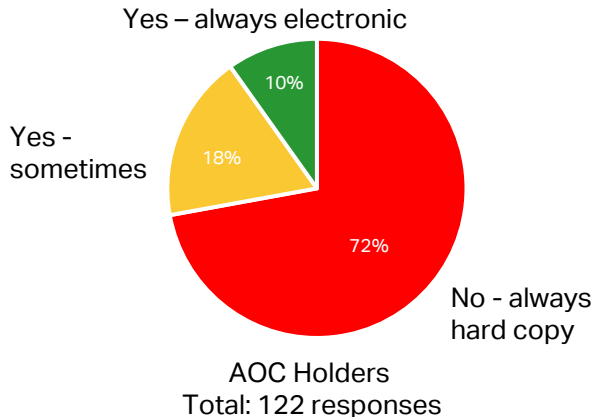


*AOC - Air Operators Certificate (AOC) (certified true copy) and operations specifications (copy)

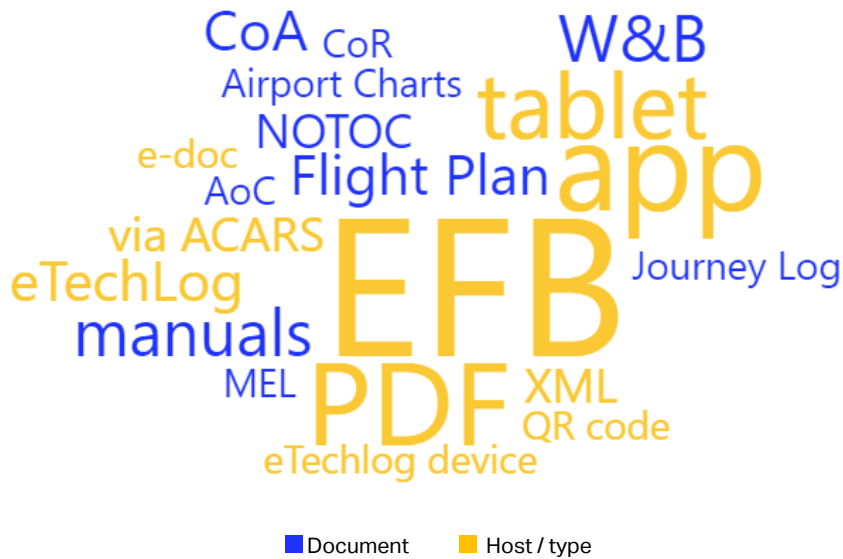

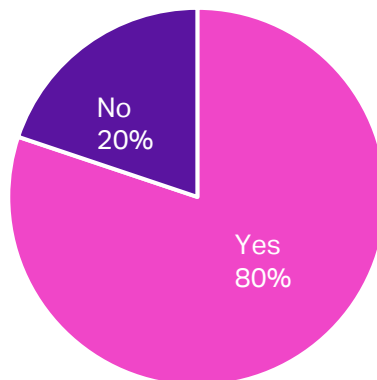
Type of documents and host application for e-format
