SUBJECT: **MAIL VOTE (A318)**
PAC2 (Mail A318)
Changes to Remittance Frequency – Italy

Background Information

Changes to Resolution 818g and 812 were adopted by PACConf/41 whereby the provisions in relation to Remittance Frequencies on a monthly basis will be rescinded effective 1 January 2020. APJC Italy had met on 12 June 2019 (quorum met) in accordance to the instructions given by the Conference to discuss about the plan for those Agents that are currently remitting their BSP Billing on a monthly basis. It was unanimously agreed to implement a new standard Remittance Frequency in Italy, as twice per month in replacement on the monthly Remittance Frequency; and for all Agents to be offered the possibility to either pay on a twice monthly basis or opt for the Voluntary More Frequency Remittance frequency of four times per month, effective 1 January 2020.

Conference is requested to adopt the proposed new Remittance Frequency for BSP Italy ahead of PACConf/42, to ensure that Agents in BSP Italy will receive sufficient notice on the options of alternative frequencies and to ensure IATA can facilitate a smooth transition.

Effective date

The proposed effective date of these changes is 1 January 2020.

Proposed Action

Conference to adopt the introduction of a new Remittance Frequency in BSP Italy, as twice per month.

Filing Period:	20 August – 3 September 2019
Effectiveness:	1 January 2020
