

Digital Identification – de-centralized solution

- The Digital ID is created by the customer on their mobile device.
- The Digital Identity is stored securely on the customers device.
- The Digital ID is only shared upon consent by the customer.
- The Digital ID is deleted from all day-of galleries once the journey is complete.







- First passenger boarding on February 14, 2023






eGate and Face Pod at AC Dedicated - YVR









eGate and Face Pods in Common Use - YVR
