EES & ETIAS

Two new border management initiatives that will affect travel to Europe
Both systems aim to facilitate legitimate travel to the EU in a secure and safe way



Entry
Exit
System

Registers visa-free and visa-required travellers entering 29 European countries for a short stay

- Starts in Q4 2024*
- Travellers' biometrics registered and verified
- Replaces physical stamps of passport
- Automatically detects overstayers
- Detects cases of multiple identities

New entry requirement for visa-free travellers to enter the 27 Schengen countries, Bulgaria, Cyprus and Romania for a short stay

- Starts in Q2 2025*
- ETIAS travel authorisation required to cross the border and stay
- EUR 7 (age: 18-70)
- Valid for 3 years
- Transition and grace periods

NEW TRAVEL PROCESS TO EUROPE

PRE-DEPARTURE

TRAVEL

Online ETIAS Application

01

Visa-free travellers apply **online** for an ETIAS travel authorisation (TA).

Payment

02

Payment of **€7** for applicants between the ages of 18 and 70.
Revenues from the fee go to the EU budget.

Processing

03

Automated check of application against databases & screening rules.
Further manual processing in case of confirmed hit.

Response to Applicants

04

Authorisation **or** refusal.
Communication via email.
Right to appeal.

Carriers

05

Air, land and sea carriers verify that travellers have a valid TA or short-term visa prior to boarding.

At the border

06

(First time registration)
Verification of travel document (**passport**) and **visa or ETIAS authorisation.**
Biometrics verification.

Possibility of pre-registration for first time travellers





CHANGES FOR TRAVELLERS

Entry
Exit
System

- No prior action required from travellers before they start their trip
- Registration at first crossing. Verification at all subsequent crossings
- Replaces manual stamping of passports
- Collects travellers' biometric and biographical data, and date and place of entry / exit
- Automatically detects multiple identities across EU systems



ETIAS
European Travel Information
and Authorisation System

- ETIAS - a travel authorisation, **NOT** a visa
- Travellers must obtain their travel authorisation before starting the trip
- Valid 3 years or till passport expires, whichever comes first. Status can be checked online.
- No biometric or health data is collected with ETIAS
- Support on how to apply via FAQs and email
- No fallback option, i.e. no ETIAS means no entry

CHANGES FOR CARRIERS



- Obligation for **commercial carriers and private jets** carrying fee-based pax
- Electronic verification through **carrier interface**. Carriers will need to register to use it
- Obligation for carriers to **verify within 48h prior to departure** that pax have a valid ETIAS or a visa
- Carriers may be **liable and subject to penalties** if failing to comply
- Response from the gateway: **OK** / **NOT OK** / **NOT APPLICABLE** (no further handling codes)
- **Support 24/7** for technical and operational issues (via online ticketing system)

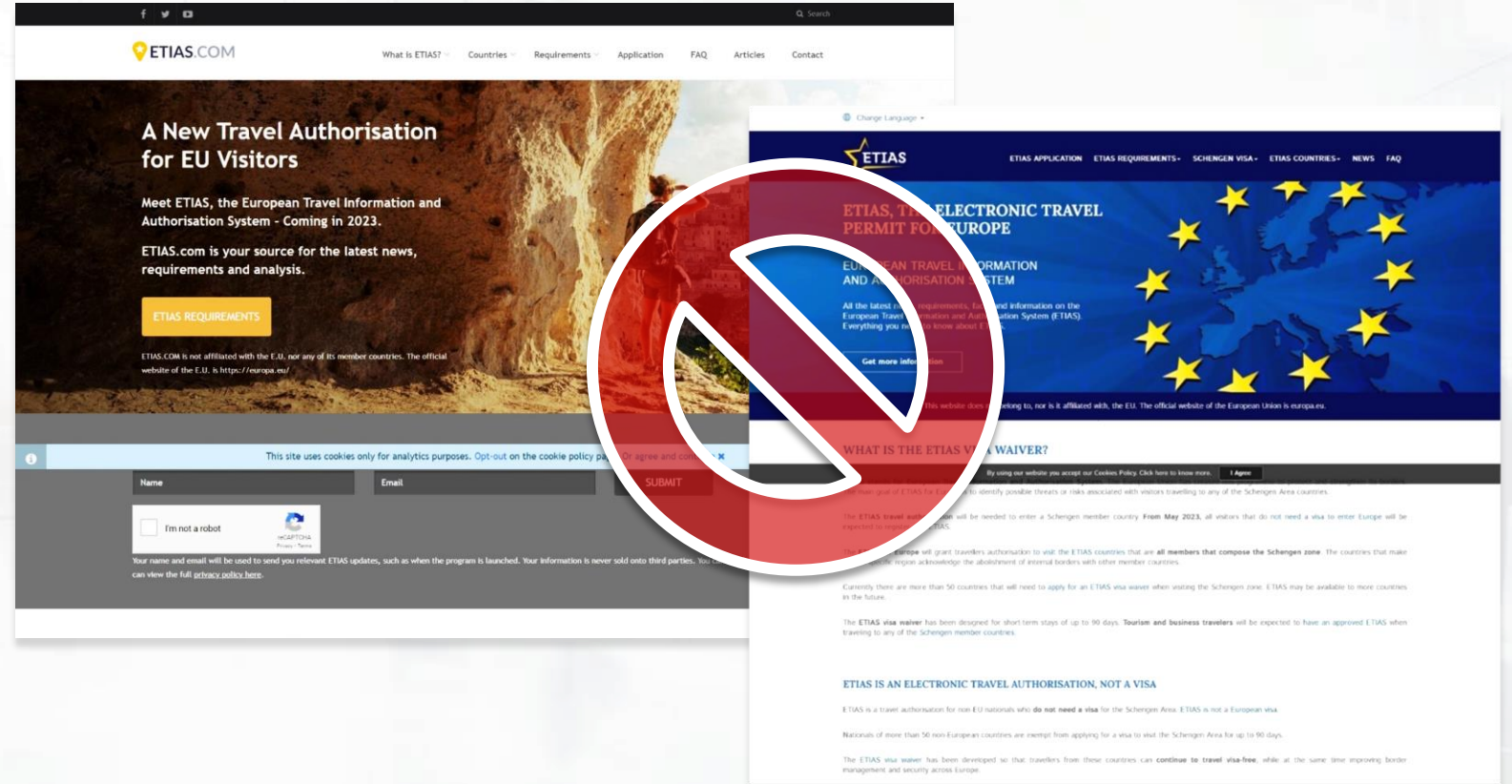
