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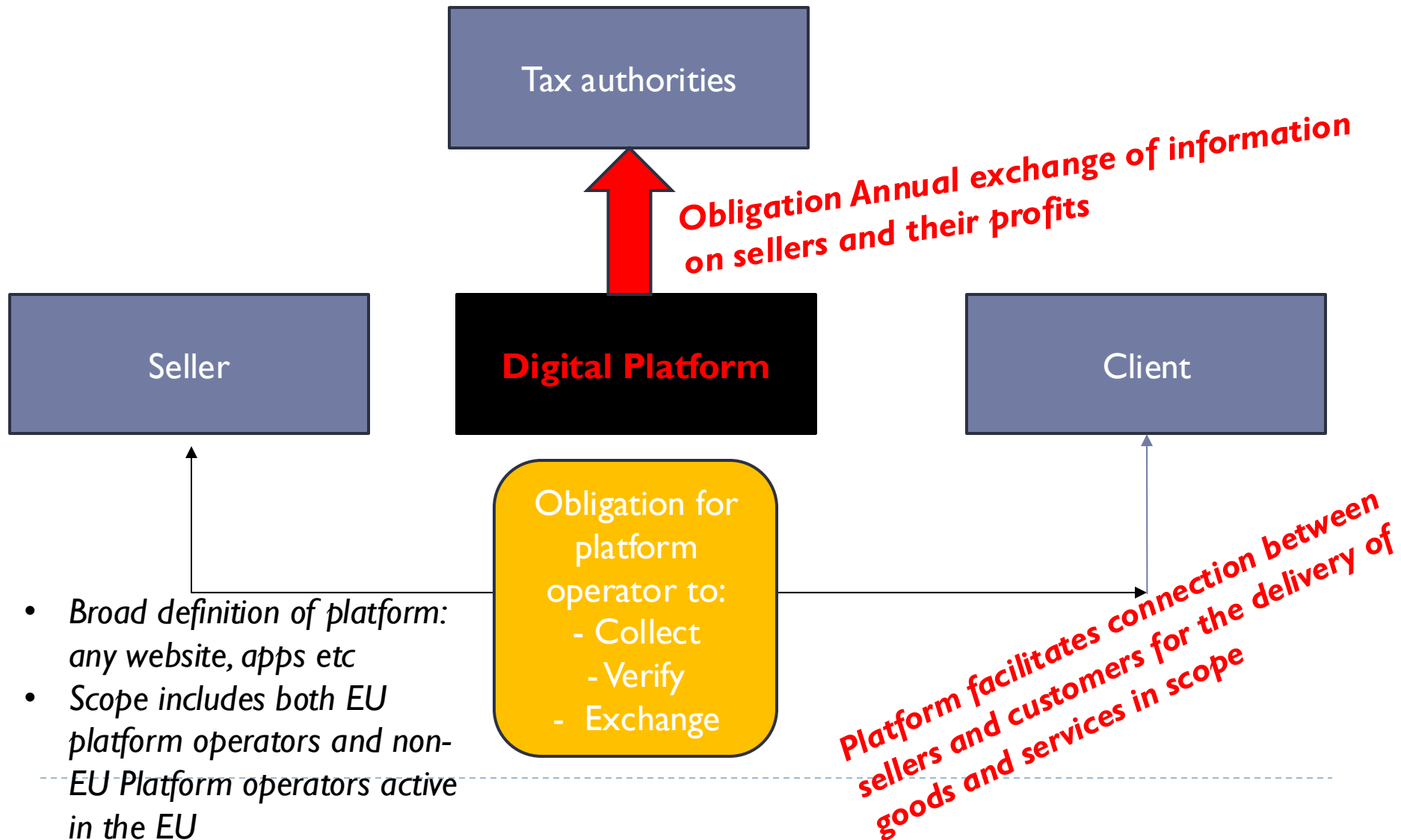
1. Rising to the Compliance Challenge in a Digitalized World

- I. **Transport Taxes as a Growing Burden:** think e.g. Air Passenger Duty (“APD”) and carbon taxes under the EU Emission Trading System (ETS)....
 - II. **Impact on Ticket Pricing Models:** airlines obliged to adjust pricing in order to accommodate different tax obligations like APD and environmental levies
 - III. **Learning from Digital Companies:** you have no solution but start to invest (yesterday!) in automation: what does it mean?
 - **Example:** Airline XYZ adjusted its pricing model by developing dedicated algo to mitigate APD and environmental taxes on long-haul routes
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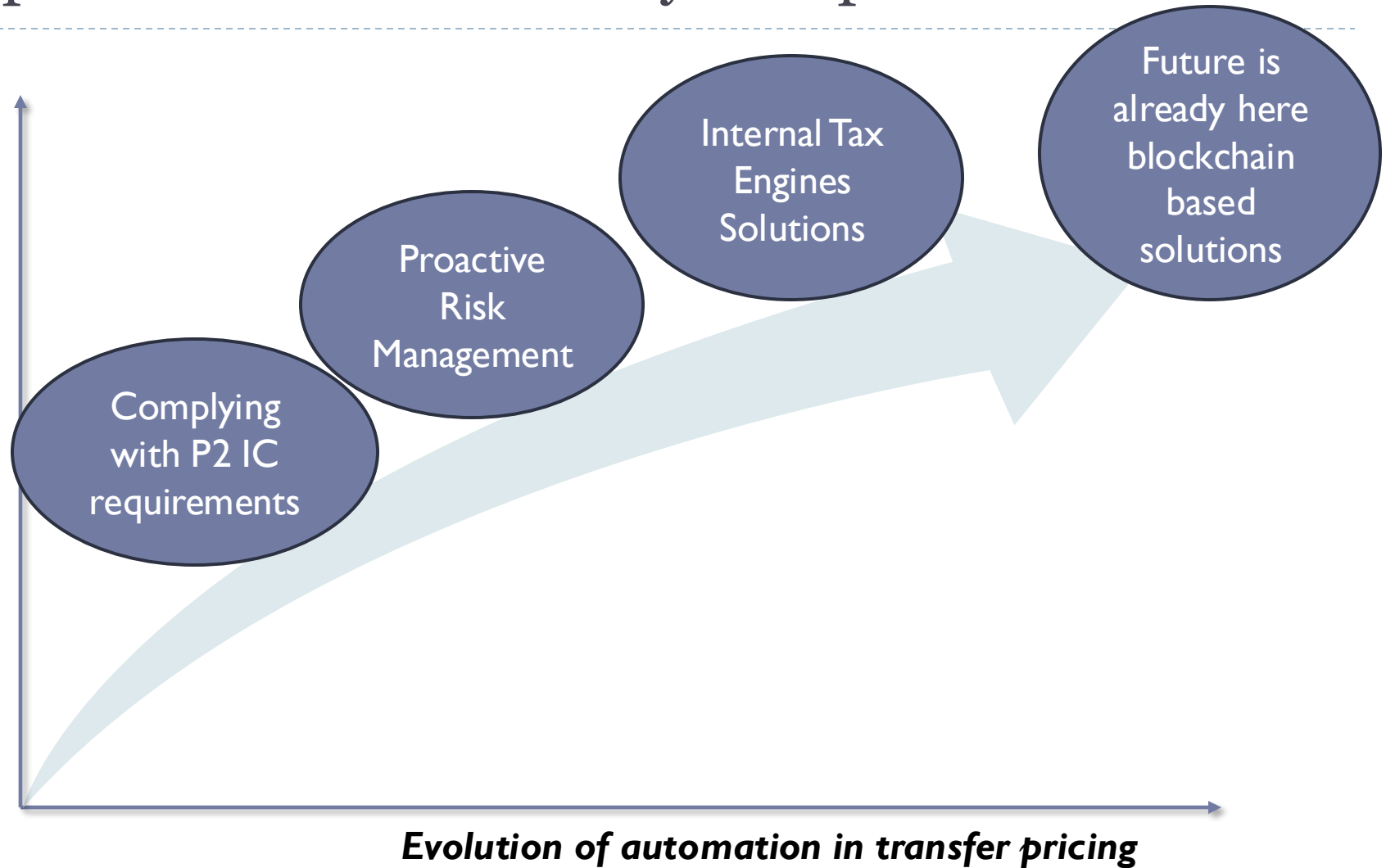
2. Automating Indirect Tax Compliance: The Digital Revolution

- I. **DAC7 and Digital Reporting (more on next slide...):** setting a precedent by digital platforms for X-border reporting, relevant to all industries
 - II. **AI-Driven Tax Engines:** tools like e.g. Thomson Reuters ONESOURCE automatically calculate VAT/GST for real time compliance across multiple countries
 - III. **E-invoicing Mandates:** real time reporting increasing getting traction (e.g. Italy, KSA) and more to come

4. Preparing for the Future: Trends in Tax Compliance

1. **Environmental Taxes and Evolving Legislation:** airlines shall factor in the integration of carbon taxes into their systems, especially with the EU pushing for green policies
 2. **Blockchain for Compliance:** some travel tech peers are already adopting blockchain to ensure transparency in e.g. rental income reporting. Airlines could consider similar systems for carbon taxes and other similar levies
 3. **Automation, Automation, Automation:** Assuming the increasing compliance costs, if you want to stay away from manual errors having a sound tax engine is key

5. Some Food for Thought...

1. **Invest in Automation:** implement AI-driven tax systems to streamline indirect tax compliance
 2. **Leverage Blockchain:** use it for transparent tracking of carbon taxes and IC transactions
 3. **Adopt E-invoicing Solutions:** prepare for mandatory e-invoicing progressively on a global basis and build your own tax engine
 4. **Stay ahead of Legislation:** Often government do not understand the cost-benefit of the introduction of legislation which can be very costly but does little in terms of revenue raising – advocacy is key!
