Adding Value: Modal conventions



Adding Value: Differences in Modal Conventions

• Documentary requirements:

Aviation is more advanced in terms of simplification and digitalisation of documents/operations

• Defences:

Aviation has limited defences compared to other modes

• Liability limits:

Aviation operates with the highest limits of liability (but without the risk of «wilful misconduct» / «recklesness» / «gross negligence»)

• Time limits

Unlike aviation, most modes operate on a 1-year limitation period (which can be extended under certain circumstances)

• Successive carriage

Aviation has separate provisions for successive carriage and subcontracting





Adding Value: Digital Integration Across Modes

- The IATA «ONE RECORD» and the EU «FEDERATED» projects lead the way in terms of digital logistics
- Technologies such as ULD/Container monitoring, electronic cargo histories and modal monitoring have the potential to provide transparency in terms of cargo claims (double-edged sword)
- Electronic Data is more important than documents, witnesses or expert evidence





- Investigation
- Discovery
- Evidence / Documentation
- Data that may assist with defense
- Contribution and indemnity claims





Potential Montreal Convention Issues Caused by Digitalization

- Articles 4-8, 10 Documentation and sufficiency of air waybills
- Article 31 Written notice of complaint
- Article 33 Jurisdiction (where the contract has been made)



Adding Value: Claims Management

- More efficient, timely, and less costly investigation, assessment and resolution
- Better communication throughout claims process
- Enhanced levels of customer service and retention
- Rolling evaluation and assessment of data needs (internal and external)
- More definitive framework for evaluating recoveries
- More efficient analysis, understanding and reporting of claims by:
 - Event, cause, and liability including associated costs
 - Customer behaviour and experience
 - Settlement and Litigation experience








Adding Value: Risk Management

- End to End visibility allows more precise and efficient identification of loss, damage, or delay and causes
- Monitoring ongoing data requirements from and performance of data partners
- More efficient identification and analysis of claims by:
 - Product (including remedial actions for carriage)
 - Mode (including modal deficiencies and remedies)
 - Logistical segment (including "weak link" analysis)
 - Station
 - Operational non-conformity at any point in carriage
- GHA, SLA, and Station product and performance monitoring (including data performance)
- Rapid assessment of need for additional training







Adding Value: The Organisation

- Core membership and participation in corporate DTG
- Ongoing development and incorporation of digital requirements in digital strategic and operational plan
- Participation with CTO/DTG to develop specific claims and loss prevention extension for ONE Record digital adoption
- Establish inter- and intra-organisational protocols to use claims data and experience as a proactive tool to measure and improve internal operations as well as to monitor and maintain intermodal and service partner service level standards
- Use claims experience to refine customer analysis, value and experience for Commercial /Sales and Ops







Adding Value: The Real Benefit







Adding Value: The Real Benefit

- Increasing "end to end" visibility of the internal operation and entire logistical chain of carriage
- Better analysis and use of data enhances claims managers' ability to increase organisational contribution and value both operationally and financially and assures excellence in product integrity and customer service
- Increasing organisational contribution decreases traditional silo status of the claims department
- The claims department becomes an increasingly essential and key organisational resource
