| 1.11.1 | 8142871 | Minor | IATA SIS invoicing | <p>Area:ISWEB</p> <p>Issue: While creating a new location, the system was throwing 'Unexpected Error'. After analyzing this issue, we found that it is because of multiple entries of 'Subdivision Name' (here "Devon") available for the country "United Kingdom". In master 'Area Sub Division Setup', it is possible to have multiple subdivisions for a country with different subdivision codes. On IS-WEB screens, only subdivision names are populated. But in the backend, while saving subdivision name, the system also saves subdivision code associated with the subdivision name. In above scenario, since there are multiple records of 'Subdivision Name' exists for a country, while saving the system was not able to associate appropriate subdivision code with subdivision name and hence was failing to save the record.</p> <p>The similar issue also exists when modifying the value of existing subdivision name.</p> <p>We also identified the following issue:</p> <p>If any changes are made to member details (not limited to field subdivision name) and when Member details tab is saved, subdivision code associated with the location is updated as blank</p> |

On IS-WEB screens, the field 'Subdivision Name' will now populate subdivision name appended with its subdivision code 2. While saving, appropriate subdivision code will be saved, if multiple subdivisions exist for a country with the same name 3.Subdivision code will not be updated to blank |

| 1.11.1 | 8171646 | Minor | Err99 | <p>Area: ISWEB</p> <p>Issue: The issue was because of additional space in field 'AircraftRegistrationNo' in output XML.</p> <p>On analysis, we have found that it is possible to provide extra space in field if Invoice/Credit Note is captured using IS-WEB in browser IE 8 i.e. Invoice is validated without any error. We also checked the same in IE 9 and the system is correctly throwing error if space is provided.</p> <p>Currently, the system does not perform any data validation when output files are generated and hence it is generated successfully with extra space in this field.</p> <p>Corrective Action: As a preventive action, we have modified the code to perform data validation and log any such errors in the database post validating the output file with XSD. These errors will be tracked by the support team and will inform IATA for raising SF/SCP if any issues are found.</p> <p>Although the browser IE8 is not supported by the SIS, issue found for the field 'AircraftRegistrationNo' has been fixed. After this fix, the system will store trimmed (i.e. by removing left & right spaces) value of all the dynamic text fields captured using IS-WEB.</p> |

| 1.11.1 | 8189391 | Minor | Future updates pending | <p>Area: ISWEB</p> <p>Issue: For member, the member profile future update field "Add Tax/Vat Reg. number" was having length more than the maximum acceptable length of this field which is 25 chars. Due to this, while applying future updates for period Aug P3 2017 it got failed and updates for other members were also not completed.</p> <p>Corrective Action: We tested this issue on multiple browsers. However, it is not reproducible (inserting "Add Tax/Vat Reg. number with more than 25 chars") on our QA environment. As a part of preventive action, we have introduced a new check which will not allow user to provide the value higher than the maximum acceptable length of that field.</p> <p>This is a common check which has been implemented for all the Member profile future update fields accepting String values.</p> |

The node for VAT calculated amount having value as "Zero (0.00)" was not printed in output IS-XML and was skipped at both Tax Breakdown as well as Invoice Summary levels.</p> <p>Corrective Action: We have done code changes to fix this issue. With these changes node <TaxAmount> will be printed at both the levels Tax breakdown as well as Invoice Summary in output IS-XML, even if it has "Zero (0.00)" value.</p> |
| 1.11.1 | 8309038 | Minor | Sandbox Rel. 1.11 | <p>Area: ISWEB</p> <p>Issue: The search results of 'Resend Output Files' were not displayed as per the search criteria provided by the user. Even though the specific values are provided in fields 'File Status' and 'File Name', the search results were displayed without considering values of these search criteria fields.</p> <p>After analyzing this issue we identified that this issue was the impact of changes made in the 'Completed Jobs' section as part of CMP #711 in Release 1.11.0.0.</p> <p>Corrective Action: Code changes have been done to correctly display records as per given search criteria.</p> |
