1.9.6	7631466	Major	Admin Alert - Parsing and Validation failure notification - SIS Production	<p>Area:IS WEB PAX</p> <p>Issue: There was an issue in the PAX Form C Parsing and Validation module when Form C's are submitted using IS-IDEC or Form C XML files. If a file in error was deleted from the Processing Dashboard and was resubmitted using the same filename, the process still failed. It did not take into account the deleted file(s) and assumed that there was more than one input file.</p> <p>Corrective Action: The code has been fixed to exclude file(s) that have already been deleted by the member</p>
1.9.6	7604178	Minor	Clear out Alerts	<p>Area: IS-WEB</p> <p>Issue: The system does not automatically purge expired Alerts and Messages generated for IS-WEB users. This leads to a large number of Alerts and Messages being displayed in the IS-WEB home page screen.</p> <p>Corrective Action: The code has been modified to add a process that will purge expired Alerts and Messages. The retention period will be as per System Parameter "Default Message Exp. Days", which is currently defined as 3 days.</p> <p>Also, code has been added to purge Broadcast Announcements as well, using the Expiry Date defined by SIS Ops users at the time of creating such Announcements (through IS Web screen "Home&gt;&gt; SIS Ops &gt;&gt; Broadcast Messages").</p>
