### Notice of the 9<sup>th</sup> Simplified Invoicing and Settlement (SIS) Annual General Meeting

In light of the COVID-19 Global Pandemic and its effect on our member airlines IATA, in consultation with the SIS Steering Group decided to cancel the 9th Simplified Invoicing and Settlement (SIS) Annual General Meetings which was to be held in Dubai, on 29th September 2020.

In order to stay engaged during this time, we invite you to participate to our SIS 2020 Update Webinars. This webinar will, at a reduced scope, provide you with an annual updates from the SIS Steering Group and inform you on important industry topics. The webinar will be held on Tuesday, 29th September 2020 and **an official invitation will be distributed shortly**. Taking into consideration the current context and the new format of the meeting, there will be no items for voting this year.

### New Dispute Module for Miscellaneous Bilateral Invoices

We are pleased to announce the implementation of a new dispute functionality for Miscellaneous Bilateral Invoices, which allows a simplified and integrated dispute process for bilateral invoices. This new functionality offers an alternative to the existing rejection process which is used mainly for Clearing House invoices. Disputes can be created manually via the IS-WEB interface or can be submitted via CSV file. Detailed instructions, file specifications and sample files are available on our website [here](#). The CSV listings implemented in Nov 2017 with Major Release 1.11 can be used as the input file for creating a dispute. Detailed guidelines on how to enable the CSV listings are available [here](#).

The new functionality can be used to dispute E&F invoices for aeronautical charges, and the CSV listing generated by SIS can serve as the dispute input file. The SIS CSV listing is replacing the

'dispute CSV' attachment previously provided by the E&F Team.

We invite you to review the available documentation and start making use of the new dispute module.

## SIS Location ID feature – how to maximize benefits

Over the last few years we have expanded the usage of the Location ID functionality with additional features which enable automation with SIS, segregation of duties, legal compliance, etc. You can now control user access and contact notifications to specific Location ID, define default Location IDs to be used for payable invoices, per billing customer, have separate output files generated per Location ID and routed to separate iiNET accounts, route validation reports to specific iiNET accounts and much more. We encourage all Participants to review the functionality and make use of the benefits it brings.
