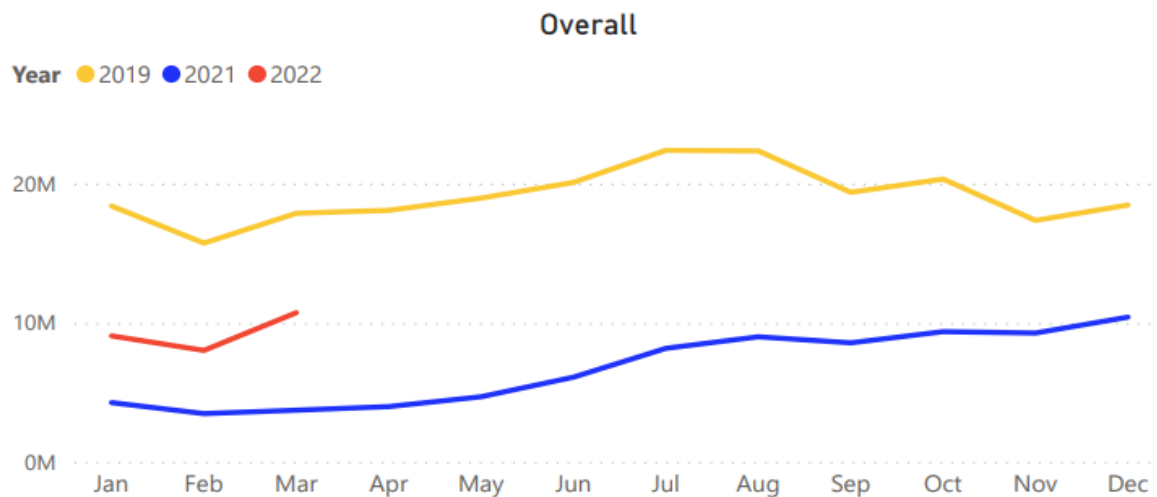

COVID-19: SIS Monthly Update

Dear SIS Participants,

Welcome to the March update of the COVID-19 SIS report reflecting over the first quarter of 2022. As different world Governments begin to reduce restrictions and mandates, travel is expected to increase throughout the year.

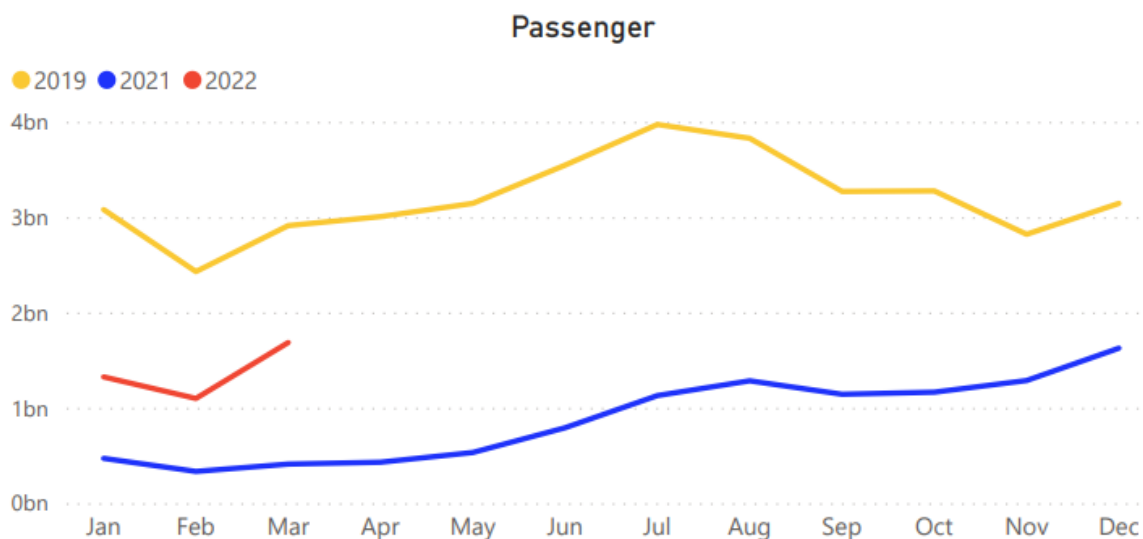
The number of transactions processed in March increased by 33% compared to February 2022. Comparing to previous years, there has been a 188% increase compared to March 2021 and a 39% decrease compared to March 2019. YTD values are 142% higher compared to 2021 and 46% lower compared to 2019.



Number of SIS Transactions YTD (2019 vs 2021 vs 2022)

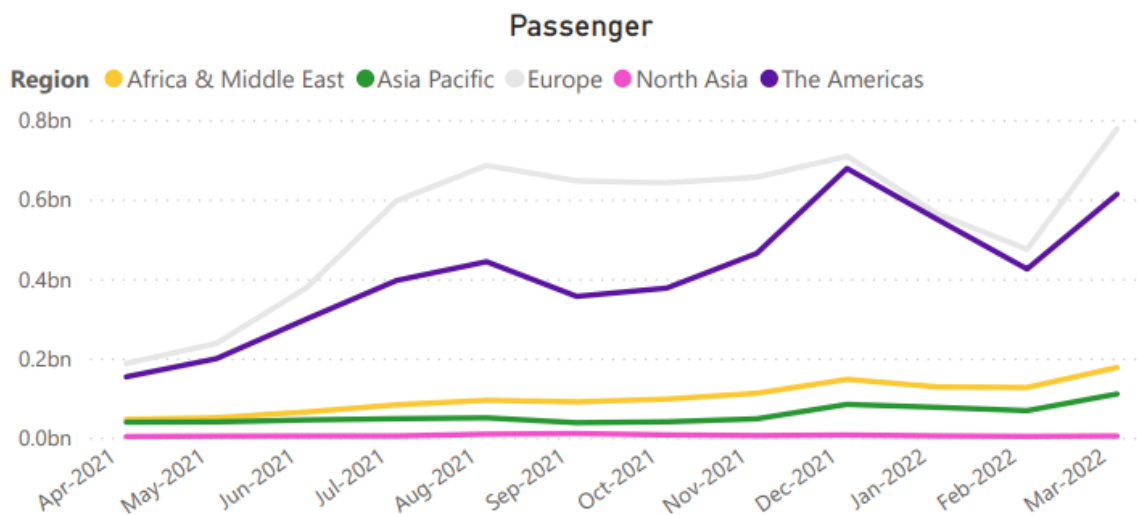
Overall invoice counts increased in March, experiencing a gain of 3.4% compared to last month. This overall gain is largely due to the 6% increase that the Passenger category experienced this month. Comparing to previous years there has been a 22% gain compared to March 2021 and a 32% reduction compared to March 2019. YTD values are 20% higher compared to 2021 and 28% lower compared to 2019.

Overall USD values experience a massive increase in March. There was a 32% increase compared to February 2022. Comparing to previous years there has been a 155% gain compared to March 2021 and a 40% decrease compared to March 2019. YTD values are 375% higher compared to 2021 and 31% lower compared to 2019.



USD Value (2019 vs 2021 vs 2022)

Focusing on the Passenger category, we observe sharp increases in all regions. As the global vaccination rate reaching over 66% and international governments reducing travel restrictions, Passenger values resumes growth a slow start of the year.
