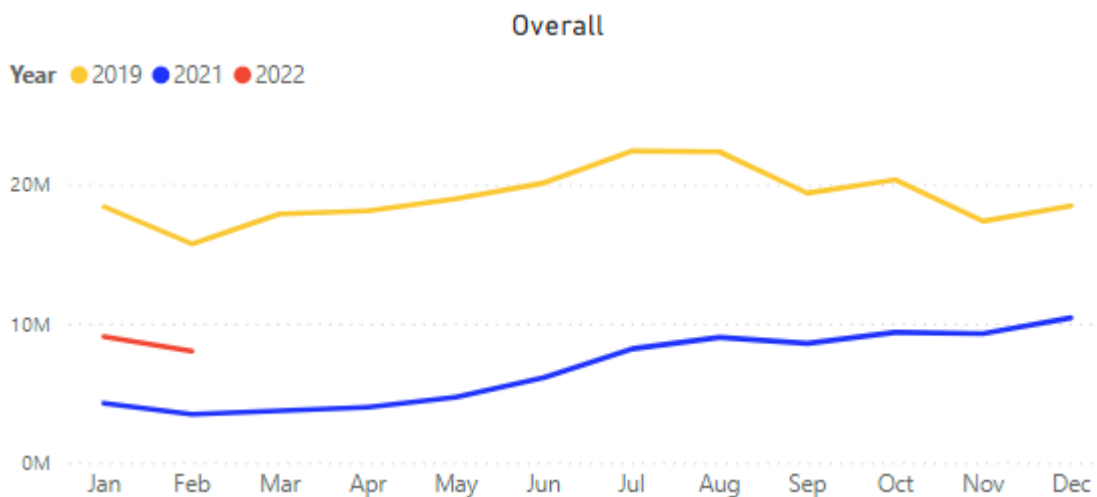

COVID-19: SIS Update, February 2022

Dear SIS Participants,

Welcome to the February update of the COVID-19 SIS report. Over 64% of the global population has received at least one dose of the Covid-19 vaccine, and Governments around the world are relaxing travel restrictions and COVID mandates. As different world governments begin to reduce restrictions and mandates, travel is expected to increase throughout the year.

The number of transactions processed in February decreased by 11% compared to January 2022. Comparing to previous years, there has been a 130% increase compared to February 2021 and a 49% decrease compared to February 2019.

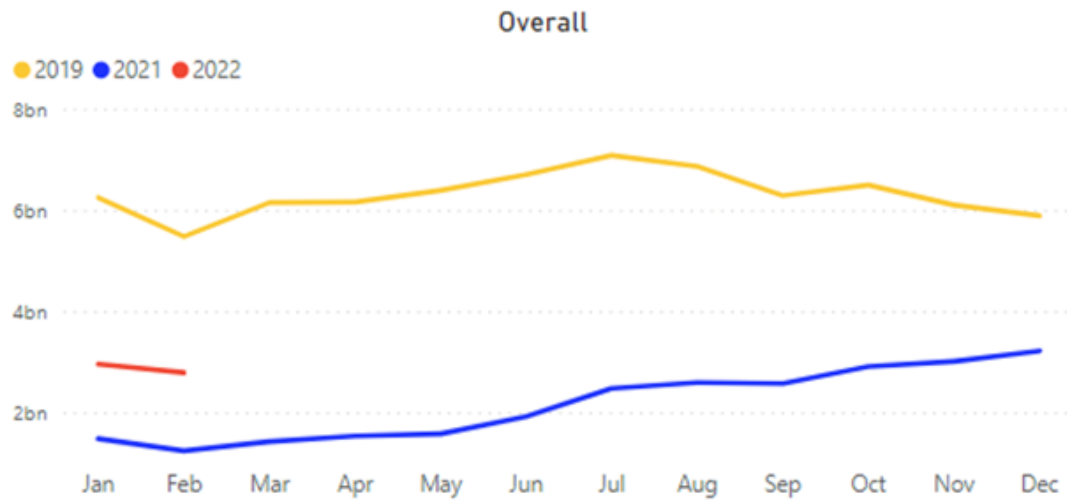


Number of SIS Transactions YTD (2021 vs 2020 vs 2019)

Overall invoice counts decreased in February, experiencing a difference of 3.8% compared to last month. Comparing to previous years there has been a 19% gain

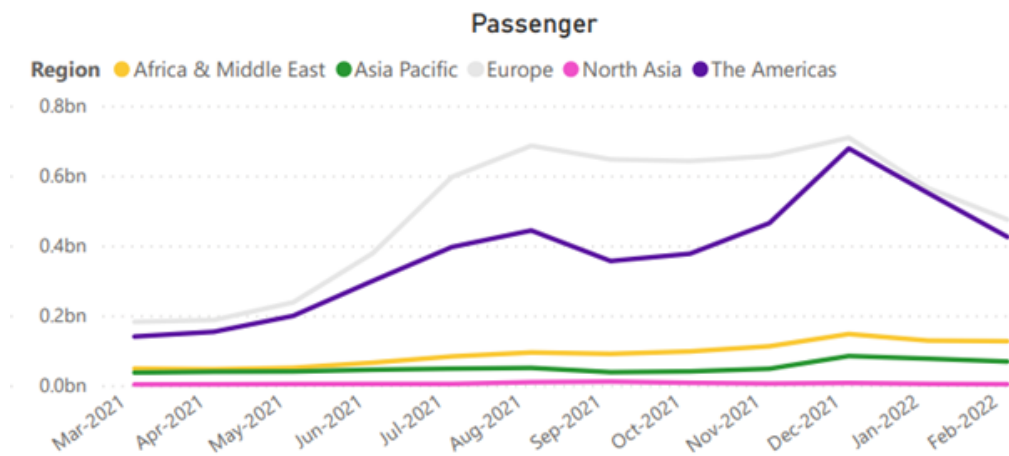
compared to February 2021 and a 24% reduction compared to February 2019.

Overall USD values slowdown in February. There was a 5.5% decrease compared to January 2022. Comparing to previous years there has been a 125% gain compared to February 2021 and a 49% decrease compared to February 2019.



Invoice Count YTD (2021 vs 2020 vs 2019)

Focusing on the Passenger category, we observe sharp declines in all regions. Despite the global vaccination rate reaching over 64% and international governments reducing travel restrictions, Passenger values continue its decline for the second month in a row
