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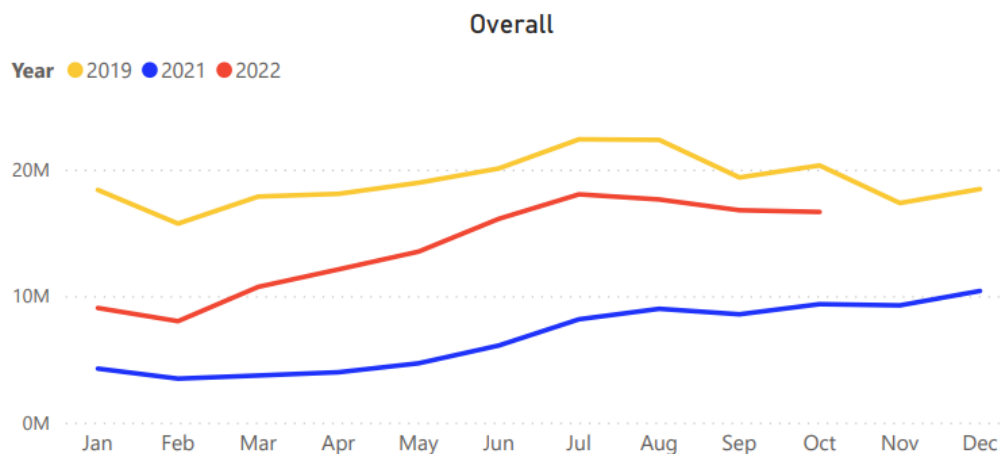

SIS Volumes Monthly Update

Dear SIS participants, Welcome to the October update of the SIS Volumes Monthly Update.

The number of overall transactions processed in October decreased by 0.80% compared to last month. Comparing to previous years, Overall transactions experience a 77.81% increase compared to October 2021 and a 18.08% difference compared to October 2019. Overall YTD values are 126.09% higher compared to 2021 and 28.36% lower compared to 2019.

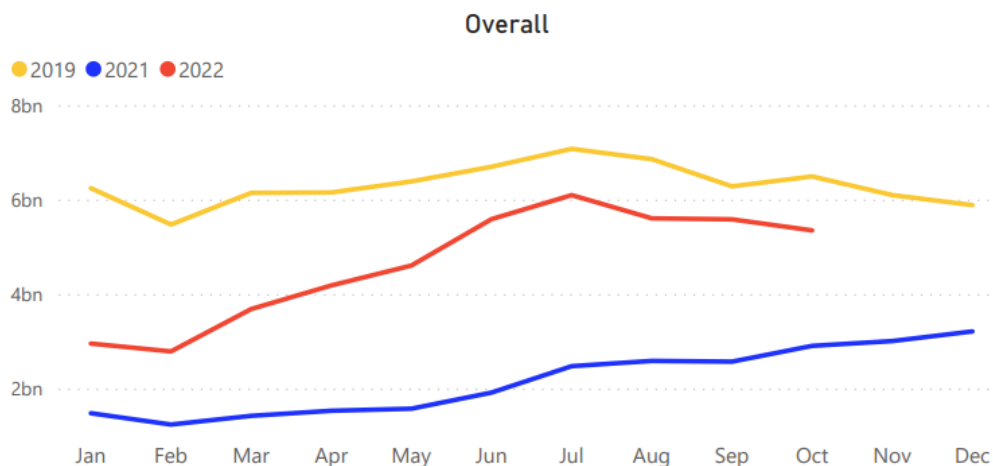


Number of SIS Transactions YTD (2019 vs 2021 vs 2022)

Overall Invoice Counts see a increase of 45.5% compared to September 2022. Focusing on the Passenger category, we see a difference of 0.38% compared to September 2022. Comparing the Passenger category to other months, we see a 46.38% increase compared to October 2021 and a 28.65% difference compared to

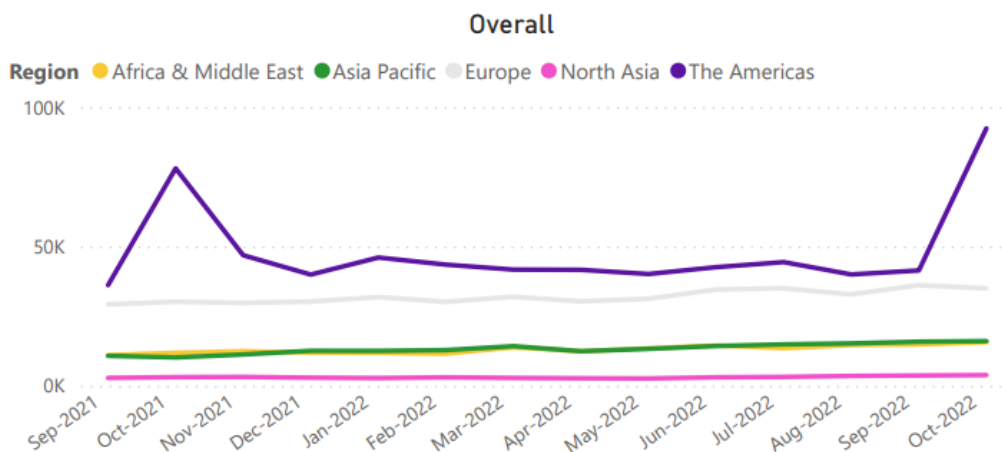
October 2019. Overall YTD values are 21.3% higher compared to 2021 and 26.4% lower compared to 2019. The peaks in October 2022 are due to IATA's annual e-invoicing activity.

Overall USD values experiences a slowdown of 4.19% compared to last month. Comparing to previous years, Overall Transaction values increased 84.21% compared to October 2021 and see a difference of 17.6% compared to October 2019. Overall YTD values are 135.82% higher compared to 2021 and 27.23% lower compared to 2019



USD Value (2019 vs 2021 vs 2022)

Overall invoice counts in October experience gains in nearly all regions compared to last month, September 2022. Invoice counts are highly dependent on passenger travel, thus we expect fluctuation until the next travel season. The peaks in October 2022 and October 2021 are due to IATA's annual e-invoicing activity.
