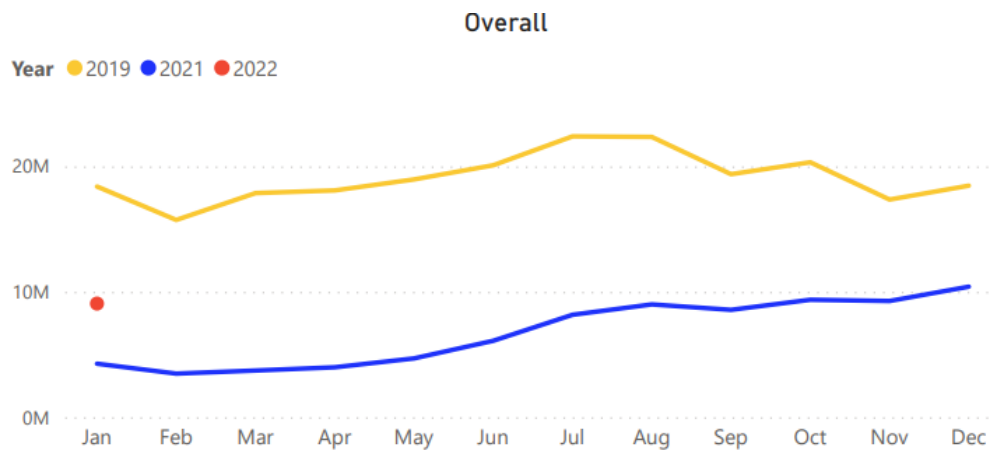

COVID-19: SIS Monthly Update

Dear SIS Participants,

Welcome to the first issue of the COVID-19 SIS update for 2022. Over 62% of the global population has received at least one dose of the Covid-19 vaccine, and Governments around the world are relaxing travel restrictions and COVID mandates. As different world governments begin to reduce restrictions and mandates, we expect travel to increase throughout the year.

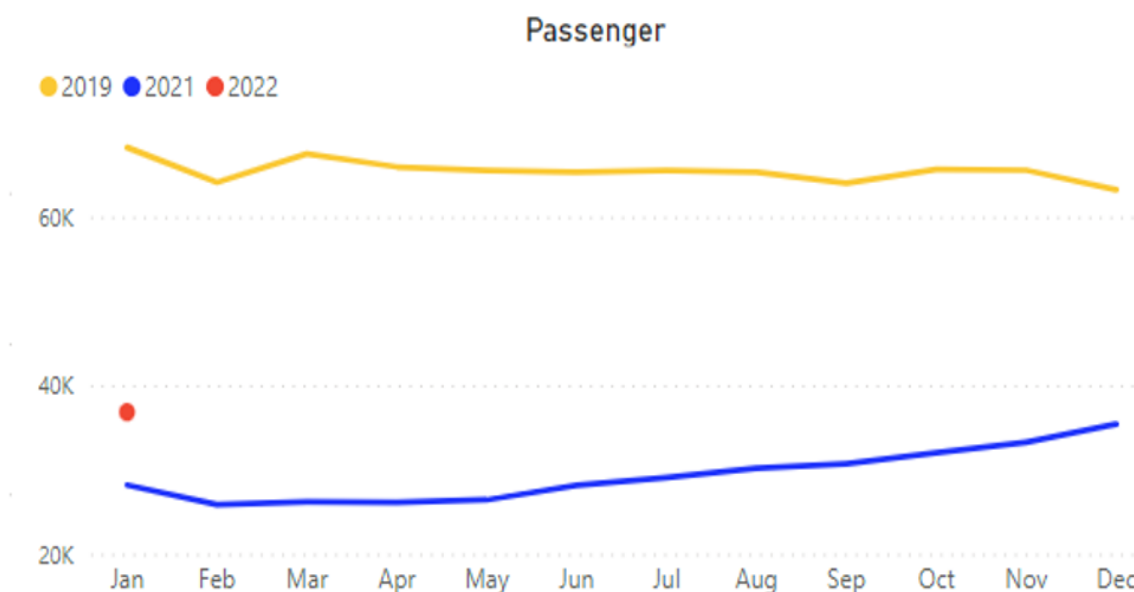
The number of transactions processed in January 2022 decreased by 12% compared to last month, December 2021. Comparing to previous years, we observe a 112% increase compared to January 2021 and a 50% decrease compared to January 2019.



Number of SIS Transactions YTD (2019 vs 2021 vs 2022)

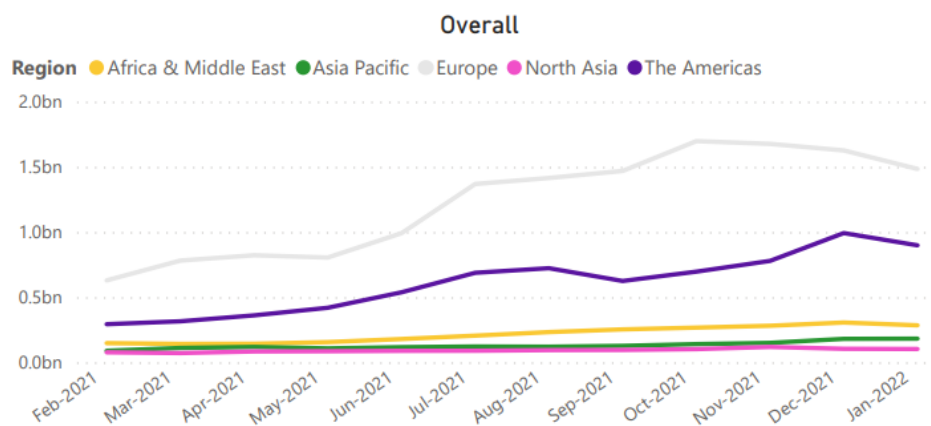
As we begin a new year, we focus on the Passenger category, invoice counts increase by 4% compared to December 2021. January 2022 was the 11th month in a row which experienced growth. Additionally January 2022 has the highest volume of Passenger invoices compared to any month in 2021. This consistent growth is expected to continue during 2022. Comparing to previous years we observe Pax invoice counts increasing by 30% compared to January 2021 and a 46% difference compared to December 2019.

Overall USD values start 2022 off slowly with a difference of 8% compared to December 2021. Compared to previous years we see a 99% gain compared to January 2021 and a 52% difference compared to January 2019.

Overall, almost all regions observed decreases in USD values processed compared to last month, December 2021. Despite the slow start to the year, growth is expected throughout 2022 as the global vaccination rate has reached over 62% and governments continue to reduce travel restrictions.
