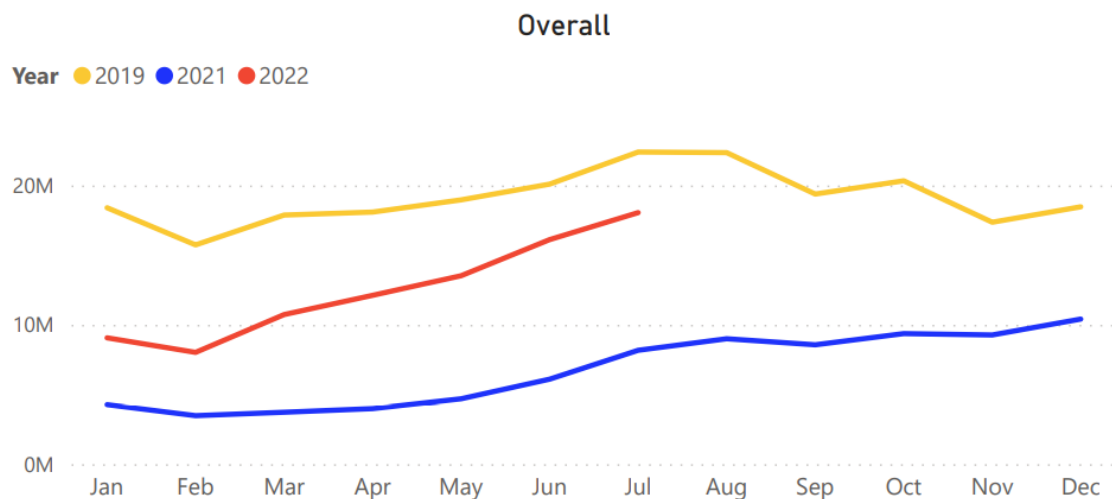

### SIS Volumes Monthly Update

Dear SIS Participants,

Welcome to the July update of the SIS Volumes Monthly Update. This report is a continuation of the Monthly Covid-19 SIS report which have been sent out since 2020. As the pent up demand for international travel begins to reach its apex Passenger transactions show strong signs of recovery.

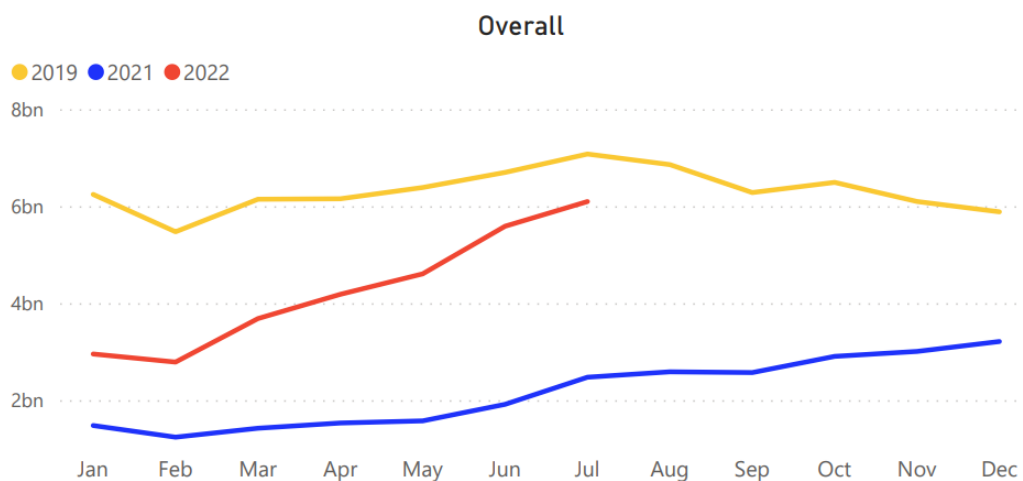
The number of transactions processed in July increased by 12% compared to last month. Comparing to previous years, we observe a 120% increase compared to July 2021 and a 19% difference compared to July 2019. YTD values are 154% higher compared to 2021 and 33% lower compared to 2019.



Number of SIS Transactions YTD (2019 vs 2021 vs 2022)

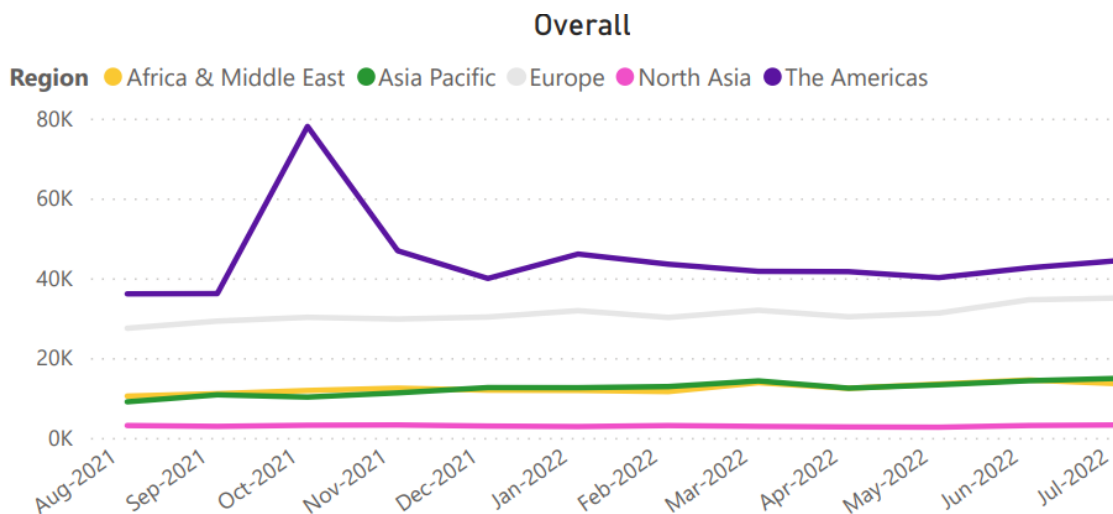
Overall Invoice Counts see strong growth of 1.87% compared to June 2022. Focusing on the Passenger category, we see gains of 1.7% compared to June 2022. Comparing the Passenger category to other months, we see a 54.6% increase compared to July 2021 and a 31.4% difference compared to July 2019. YTD values are 47.3% higher compared to 2021 and 39.4% lower compared to 2019.

Overall USD values continue to experience massive increases as Passenger transaction values see a 16.3% increase compared to June 2022. Comparing to previous years, Passenger Transaction values increased 233.9% compared to July 2021 and see a difference of 5.1% compared to July 2019. YTD values are 303% higher compared to 2021 and 34% lower compared to 2019.



USD Value (2019 vs 2021 vs 2022)

Overall invoice counts in July experiences growth in nearly all regions compared to last month, June 2022. We expect this growth to slow down as summer travel approach its apex.
