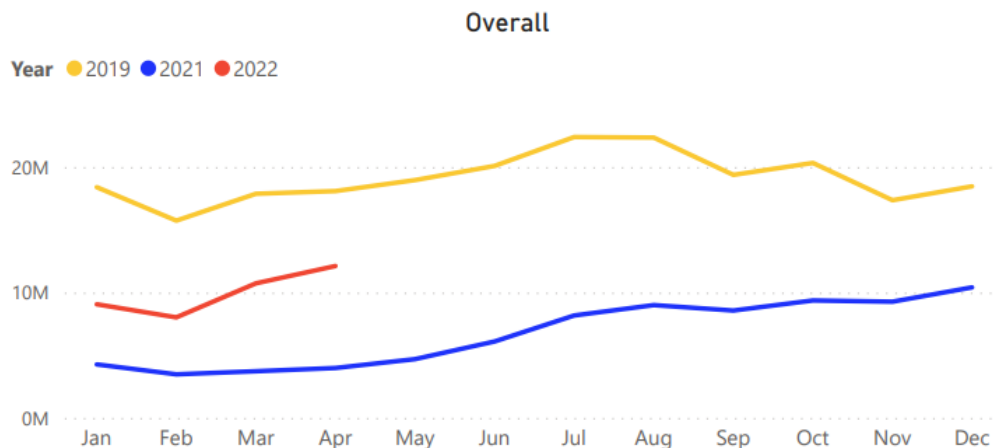

COVID-19: SIS Monthly Update

Dear SIS Participants,

Welcome to April update of the COVID-19 SIS Update. As different world Governments begin to reduce restrictions and mandates, travel is expected to increase throughout the year.

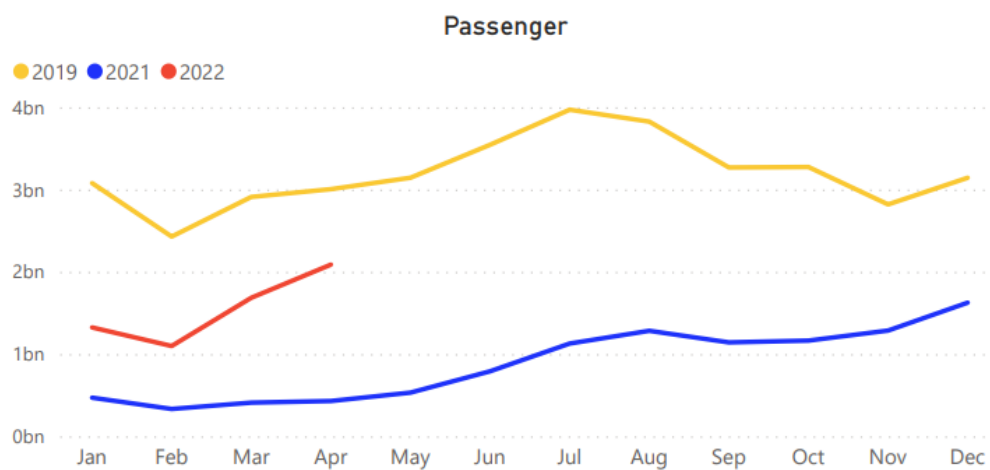
The number of transactions processed in April increased by 12% compared to last month. Comparing to previous years, we observe a 204% increase to April 2021 and a 33% decrease compared to April 2019. YTD values are 158% higher compared to 2021 and 43% lower compared to 2019.



Number of SIS Transactions YTD (2019 vs 2021 vs 2022)

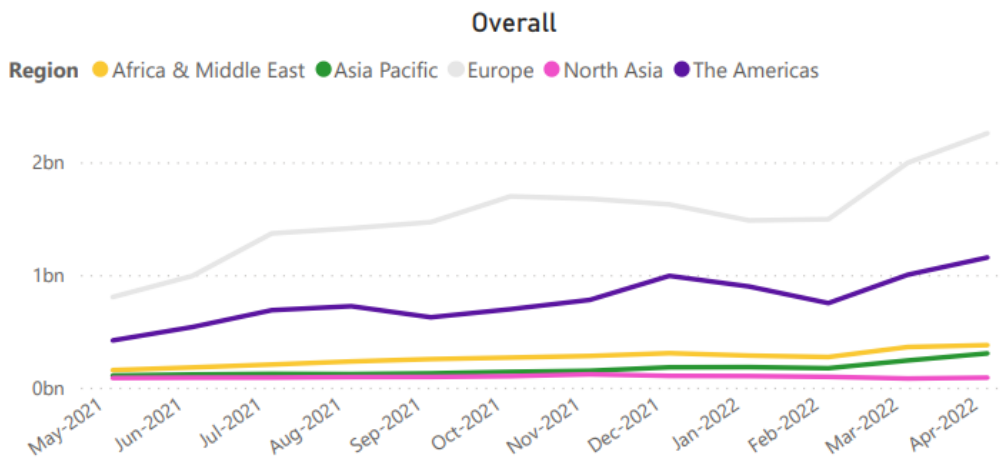
Invoice counts decreased in April, experiencing a decrease of 4.8% compared to last month. This overall decrease is largely due to the 8.7% decrease that the Non-Transportation category experienced this month. Comparing to previous years there has been a 15% gain compared to April 2021 and a 31% difference compared to April 2019. YTD values are 19% higher compared to 2021 and 29% lower compared to 2019.

Overall USD values experience a massive increase in April for the second consecutive month. There was a 13% increase compared to March 2022. Comparing to previous years there has been a 173% gain compared to April 2021 and a 32% decrease compared to March 2019. YTD values are 140% higher compared to 2021 and 43% lower compared to 2019.



USD Value (2019 vs 2021 vs 2022)

Focusing on the Passenger category, we observe sharp increases in all regions. As the global vaccination rate reaching over 66% and international governments reducing travel restrictions, Passenger values resumes growth.
