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➤ SIS Recharge for 2018

In July P4 2019 signatories to the Standard Agreement for SIS Participation (ISPA) have received an invoice from IATA Montreal (XB-A89) representing the recharge of the revenue deficit for the operational year 2018. The amount recharged has been calculated proportionally to the SIS fees paid by the participant in 2018.
