➤ **Scope of Upcoming Major Release 1.6**

The next major release of the SIS Production System will be Release 1.6 in November 2014. In preparation for this upcoming event, the [Major Release 1.6 Scope Document](#) has been published on the SIS website. SIS Release 1.6 is scheduled to be deployed for the start of the November P1 2014 clearance.

➤ **SIS 2013 Surplus Refund to Participants**

As defined in the IS Participation Agreement, SIS is a cost recover service and any surplus or deficit amounts will be shared between all participants proportionally to the total paid in the relevant year. Total paid by participant will include participation and transaction fees.

We have concluded our 2013 operational year with a surplus in fee collection compared to the SIS costs. Therefore, we will be refunding all SIS members who have contributed to the 2013 annual and transaction fees. The amount to be refunded will be a direct representation of your company's contribution in the total SIS participation fees for 2013.
