➤ **Downtime for SIS Major Release 1.6 Deployment**

Deployment of SIS Major Release 1.6 on the SIS Production environment will begin on November 7th, 2014 at 23:30 Eastern Standard Time and will last approximately 7 hours.

➤ **SIS Release 1.6 Changes Now Available in the SIS Sandbox**

Changes for SIS Major Release 1.6 were deployed on the SIS Sandbox on Wednesday October 8th, 2014. We encourage all members to submit test files in the SIS Sandbox to ensure compliance with SIS Release 1.6 changes prior to their deployment on SIS Production.

➤ **Corrections to ISPG v3.4**

We have made some minor corrections to the ISPG v3.4 which are now available in the ISPG package on the [SIS Website](#). Please find the changes highlighted below:

- The Miscellaneous Input Sample Files have been updated with the new Charge Codes based on changes implemented with CMP 636. You can find the changes outlined in the [SIS 1.6 Release Notes](#)
- Passenger IS-IDEA Record Structure – Invoice Header Record elements 29 and 30 (CH Due Date and CH Agreement Indicator fields). The position was previously published incorrectly. These are the two new fields added for CMP 624 (SMI “X”). The correct position has been updated to:
 - CH Due Date: Positions 211-216
 - CH Agreement Indicator: Positions 217-221

➤ **SIS Quick Tips**

It's advised to check the Processing Dashboard (in IS-WEB under the Reports tab) prior to each period closure to ensure all invoices are in the “Ready for Billing” or “Claimed” status. Invoices in “Open” status will not be automatically closed and submitted at the end of the period.

An alert can also be created to notify members in case any invoices are not in a final status at the end of the billing period. This can be configured in the Member Profile under the “Contacts” tab in IS-WEB. Please contact sisoperations@iata.org for any additional information.
