➤ **SIS Release 1.9 Changes deployment in the SIS Sandbox**

Changes for SIS Major Release 1.9 have been deployed on the SIS Sandbox. We encourage all Members to submit test files in the SIS Sandbox environment to ensure compliance with SIS Release 1.9 changes prior to the deployment on SIS Production on 8th November 2016.

As a reminder, a [Major Release 1.9 Scope Document](#) was prepared to give participants an overview of the changes going into the release. The full suite of SIS technical documentation had been updated to reflect the changes and was published on the SIS website under the [Technical Documentation page](#).

➤ **Source codes 74, 75, 76 reserved for Billing Memo Rejections**

Following the adoption of IBS OPS General Meeting – Supplementary Agenda Item SUP1, this is to inform SIS participants that source codes 74, 75, and 76 have now been reserved for Billing Memo rejection stages. Usage for these source codes will not be permitted in SIS until they are made mandatory for Billing Memo Rejections effective May P1 2017 Billing period.

They will be allocated as follows:

- Source Code 74 to be used for Stage 1 Rejections of Billing Memo
- Source Code 75 to be used for Stage 2 Rejections of Billing Memo

Source Code 76 to be used for Stage 3 Rejections of Billing Memo
