### ➤ Scope of Upcoming Major Release 1.9

The next major release of the SIS Production will be release 1.9 in November 2016. In the preparation for the upcoming event, the [Major Release 1.9 Release Notes](#) have been published on the SIS website under the [Technical Documentation](#) page. SIS Release 1.9 is scheduled to be deployed for the start of November P1 2016 clearance.

### ➤ SIS Steering Group Nominations

With the [World Financial Symposium](#) just a few weeks away, please note that the time limit for SIS Steering Group Nominations has been extended to **September 5th 2016**. The process of nominations was detailed in [SIS Bulletin Issue Number 7](#). Nominations should be submitted to [Interline Standards](#) ([is@iata.org](mailto:is@iata.org)) listing the Name, Airline, Position within the Airline and Area of Expertise: Passenger billings, Cargo billings, or Miscellaneous/Non-transportation/other billings, Finance.

### ➤ SIS Surplus Refund from 2015

In Period 4 July 2016 signatories to the IS Participation Agreement received a credit invoice from XB-A89 for the refund of the revenue surplus in 2015, only if they contributed to the revenues collected in 2015. The refund is calculated for each participant proportionately to the SIS fees paid in 2015.

The 3rd edition of the World Financial Symposium (WFS) will continue to focus on industry action to support sustained airline financial health.

Concerning Miscellaneous transactions (both Clearing House and Bilateral), we received feedback related to the data quality in the invoices, that it does not allow airlines without an automated process to leverage automatic invoice loads, nor posting, nor reconciliation. We strongly suggest that airlines facing data quality issues with their Industry Partners to come prepared to the meeting with such examples so their Industry Partner can understand and take corrective actions. This meeting is a great opportunity to solve any pending issues with your counterparts from all over the world.
