<p>Government Entry / Exit Requirements</p>	<p>As of 1 April and until 14 April, the Barbados airspace will be closed to international commercial passenger flights between 6pm and 6am. Grantley Adams airport shall remain open to: cargo and medevac flights, fuel technical stops and special authorized flights. Confirmation on crew isolation procedures pending if overnight stay is required.</p> <p>Repatriation flights can be made at the Ministry of Tourism and International Transport. Contact information: permanent secretary - Donna Cadogan at cadogand@tourism.gov.bb or 1 246 8360618.</p> <p>As of March 22, travellers arriving from China, Korea (Rep.), USA, UK or Europe will be placed under a 14-day quarantine.
