

# IATA Member Airline Complimentary Passes

IATA member airlines are eligible for **two (2) Airline Complimentary Passes** for IGHC 2020 in Mexico City, 17– 20 May 2020.

## Terms and Conditions

- Complimentary passes will be provided to IATA Airline subject matter experts responsible for procurement and/or management of ground handling service contracts (further referred to as the Passholders).
- At least one Passholder from each airline will attend the entire speed-networking session to be held during the IGHC (please see details below).
- All Passholders will be available for networking and meetings in the IGHC networking tool and will actively respond to meeting requests.
- All Passholders agree with these Terms and Conditions as well as the Cancellation and No-show policy indicated below.
- Passes are provided on the “first comes, first served” basis.

## Cancellations and No-show Policy

- Any cancellation of a complimentary pass must be done no later than 17 April 2020
- Passholders cancelling after this date, or who are No-shows at the IGHC and/or the speed-networking session will not be granted complimentary passes for any future IGHC.
- Passholders may however transfer their pass to another eligible airline delegate from the same airline before the start of the event
