### 1) Over day Aswan (Philae Temple- The High Dam-. Unfinished Obelisk)

Early morning, our representative will pick you up from your Hotel in **Cairo** to international Airport to fly to **Aswan** by Domestic flight. Upon Arrival Aswan, our tour guide will greet you with a sign shows your name on it then you will be transferred by Private A/C Vehicle to start your amazing day with **Philae Temple** which dedicated to the goddess Isis and it's a temple which tell one of the most famous Egyptian mythology of Isis and how she brought her beloved husband back to life, birth of her son Horus & mummifying Osiris after death. The temple was moved to a small island called **Agilika** after building the High Dam to preserve it from the flood & originally it was built during the reign of Ptolemy II (Egypt's Greco-Roman Period). There was obelisks in front of the temple in the past which were removed by British Consul Henry Salt in 1918 and are now in a garden in Dorset, England.



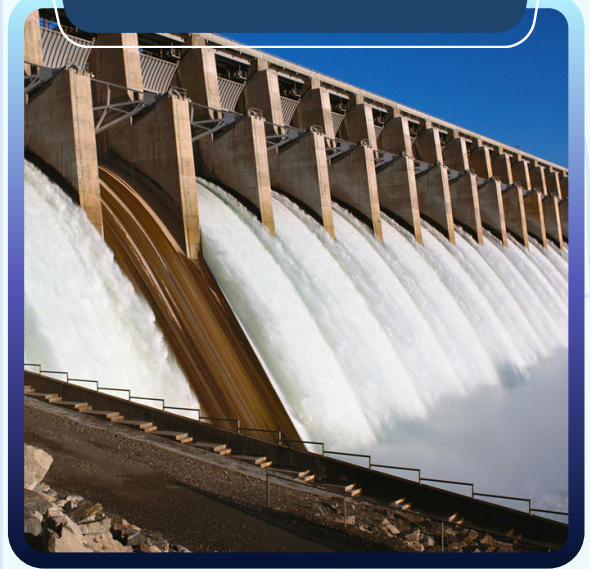
## Aswan

### Over day

**The High Dam:** It's a rock-fill dam located at the northern border between Egypt and Sudan which considered an engineering miracle to protect Egypt from annual floods from the Nile as construction for the project began in 1960 and was completed in 1968. Its measures 111m in height, 3,830m in length, and has a base width of 980m.

**Unfinished Obelisk:** It's a huge obelisk & it's one of the most famous stones left behind and it's taller than any known obelisk ever raised which abandoned when fractures appeared in its sides but still attached to bedrock. By discovering this obelisk; we have a good clue to how the ancient Egyptians quarried the hard granite with simple tools which used for building ancient temples & colossi status although it's still a big mystery the method they brought these heavy stones to Cairo which is around 500 miles away from Aswan.

Enjoy a **felucca ride on the River Nile** around Agha Khan and Elephantine Islands.





**Day 1:** Arrival - (Philae Temple- The High Dam-. Unfinished Obelisk)

Pick-up from your hotel in **Cairo** & direct to Cairo Airport to catch your flight to **Aswan**, arrive Aswan & start your tour, lunch is going to be served during your trip.

**Philae Temple** is an ancient Egyptian temple complex dedicated to the goddess Isis, renowned for its stunning, romantic location on an island in the Nile near Aswan.

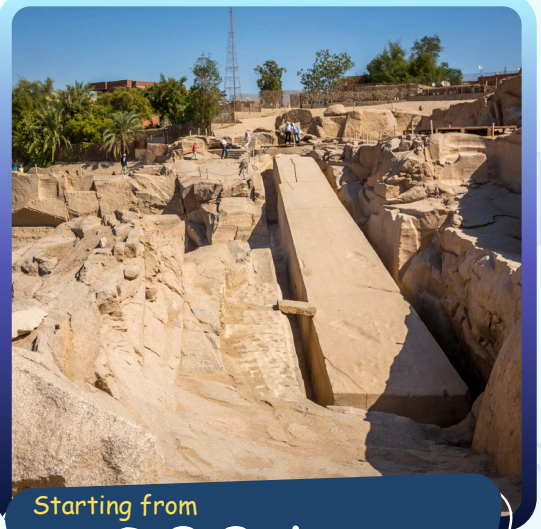
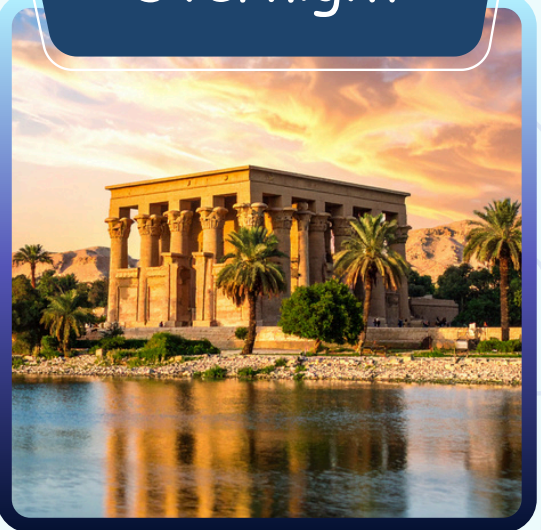
**The Aswan High Dam** is a massive rock-fill embankment dam built across the Nile in Aswan, Egypt, between 1960 and 1970. It is 111 meters high, 3,830 meters long, and created Lake Nasser, the dam controls annual Nile floods, provides water for irrigation, and generates significant hydroelectric power.

**The unfinished obelisk** is the largest known ancient obelisk and is located in the northern region of the stone quarries of ancient Egypt in Aswan.

## Day 2: Abu Simbel Temple - Departure

The larger temple is dedicated to three major Egyptian goddesses and features four large statues of Ramses II on its facade, while the smaller temple is dedicated to the love goddess Hathor, with statues designed for his beloved wife Nefertari. Moreover, lunch is going to be served during your trip.

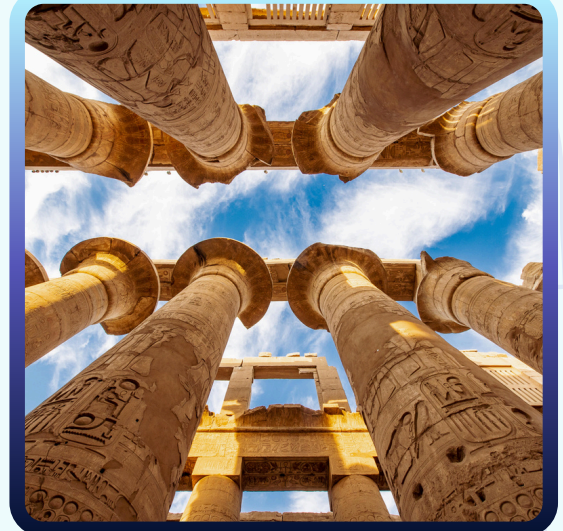

rise up toward the sheer cliff  
face, this structure is truly a  
sight to behold.
