


NDC Certification. Why?

- To provide transparency on **existing NDC deployments**: Airlines & Distributors
- To validate the capability of supporting IT providers in these instances
- To protect the NDC brand and support NDC early adopters
- To accelerate NDC adoption

NDC Certification. What?

- The capability to receive and send NDC messages
- 2. Specific **NDC end-points** as opposed to generic products



NDC Certification. Who?

Airlines

Any airline that deploys an NDC API

Distributors

Any travel agent or aggregator that consumes these APIs

IT Providers – Any vendor that offers NDC products for airlines and distributors

NDC Certification. Process

Step 1

Airlines, Distributors & IT Providers

- Apply for certification
- Complete certification form
- Capture NDC messages
- Send trace to IATA

Step 2

IATA

- Certification authority
- Validate trace

Step 3

Benefits

- Official notification
- Publication on NDC Certification Registry
- Use of IATA NDC
 Certified/Capable
 Logo

WPS 2015

- Program launch
- Accepting applications from October 2015
- Fee will be waived until end Q2 2016

- Engage with NDC community
- NDC early adopters going through certification process
