# What is the IATA Mentorship Scheme?



The IATA Emergency Response Planning (ERP) Mentorship Scheme has been created by the IATA ERP Task Force to help foster a collaborative approach across airlines with their Emergency Response and Crisis Management planning.

Within the ERP world, there are people who have several years' experience in the planning for, exercising, and sadly responding to aircraft accidents and other serious incidents. But there are also people who are just getting started or have moved to a new position in their airline and are not sure where to start.

While some airlines have big teams, codeshare or alliance partnerships, or even sister airlines, others can sometimes feel quite isolated, but what we love about ERP is that there is always someone willing to share information or advice. We just don't always know where to look for it!

Everyone occasionally needs a helping hand, someone to share ideas with and get advice from, or a sympathetic ear when things are a bit tough – that is what the scheme is designed for.

# How does the Mentorship Scheme work?



Participants may join the program as a mentor, a mentee, or in a dual capacity.

- Individuals wishing to serve as mentors are kindly asked to have a minimum of five years of professional experience in Aviation ERP or Resilience.
- Mentoring pairs will be established based on region (where feasible), language, and primary areas of professional focus.
- Upon pairing, participants will receive a **brief guide** outlining expectations and providing recommendations for a productive mentoring experience.
- Once matched, both parties will determine the preferred frequency of meetings and define the structure of the mentoring relationship to ensure it is mutually beneficial.
- This scheme is open to all ERP professionals - sole specialist within their organizations or those who are part of a larger team seeking broader insight.
