<b>Government Entry / Exit Requirements</b>	<b>Effective 19 March at 06:00</b> , all borders closed until 12 April. Exemption only granted for flights repatriating foreigners and all-cargo flights.	<b>31.3.2020</b>	Presidency
<b>Airport Entry / Exit Measures e.g. Screening</b>	Immigration to ask all passengers to declare all countries visited during the last 30 days. If passenger has visited China during the past 14 days, the officer must immediately notify the Health Authority on the port of entry in order for the health protocol to be activated. The Public Health Ministry reserves the right to require the airline to submit the passenger localization format. This must be delivered within 24 hours once notified.  Heightened screening and quarantine protocols at ports of entry.	<b>5.3.2020</b>	International SOS security alert
<b>Airline Requirements</b>	All airlines must notify passengers that board a plane in China with the Dominican Republic as the final destination, the only two airports authorized to receive these passengers are Las Americas Intl Airport and/or Punta Cana Intl Airport. All airlines are required to ask all passengers if they have visited China in the 14 days prior to travel as pre-requisite to travel to the Dominican Republic. If answer is positive, airline should issue the ticket only to the two airports mentioned before.	<b>7.2.2020</b>	Public Health Ministry
