

How Competitive is Air Transport in Poland?

Aviation supports 137,000 jobs and EUR 4 billion in economic activity in Poland

Increasing that contribution depends upon a competitive air transport industry.

This chart shows Poland broadly matches the European average for the competitiveness of its infrastructure, cargo facilitation and supply chain. But the competitiveness of regulations and passenger facilitation could be improved.


