Larger devices like laptops must be safely **put away** during taxi take-off and landing.

Always activate Flight Mode before departure.

Keeping your electronic devices safe.



We recommend that you keep them near you, i.e. not in your checked baggage.

Do not leave anything to charge unattended, or while sleeping.

Charging is not usually permitted during take-off and landing.

Alcohol and intoxication.



Only consume alcohol in moderation.



Avoid alcohol completely if you are taking medication for anxiety, or to help you sleep.



You are only permitted to consume alcohol served to you onboard by cabin crew.



Cabin crew will refuse to serve alcohol to passengers who show signs of possible intoxication

Storing your wheeled bag correctly.





If possible, turn on its side.



If not possible, lay on its back.

Make sure the locker closes before taking your seat.

Essential safety information.



If told to evacuate, DO NOT take any bags with you.



Keep your seatbelt fastened at all times while in your seat.



Do not smoke anything, anywhere onboard the aircraft.



Disruptive, violent or abusive behavior is not tolerated. Please be patient, be calm and be kind.
