Changes to Reporting Calendar - Rwanda

Background Information

APJC Rwanda met on 3 November 2021 to discuss the alignment of the remittance calendar. Members agreed to align the remittance calendar to resolution 812. 6.5.3 for both available remittance frequencies as of 1 July 2022. IATA to coordinate.

Current available remittance frequencies as listed below.

Rwanda (USD/RWF)	Twice per month	15	17	
Rwanda (USD/RWF)	Four times per Month	Refer to BSP Calendar	7	

A quorum was present. The council consists of 8 Airlines and 8 Agents. The members who attended and voted were 6 Airlines and 5 Agents.

The APJC voted unanimously to recommend the changes to Conference.

The proposed effective date of these changes is 1 July 2022.
