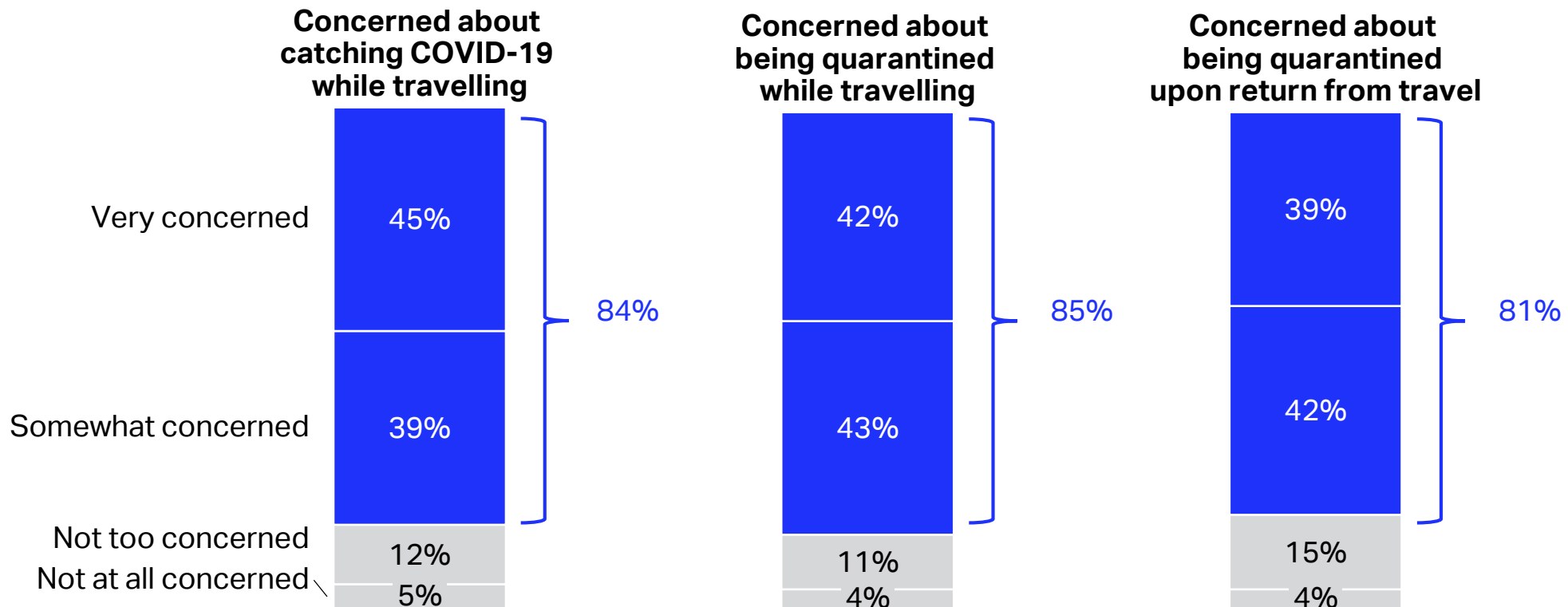

Travelers are as concerned about quarantine as they are about catching the virus

Travelers' concerns about catching the virus vs. being quarantined

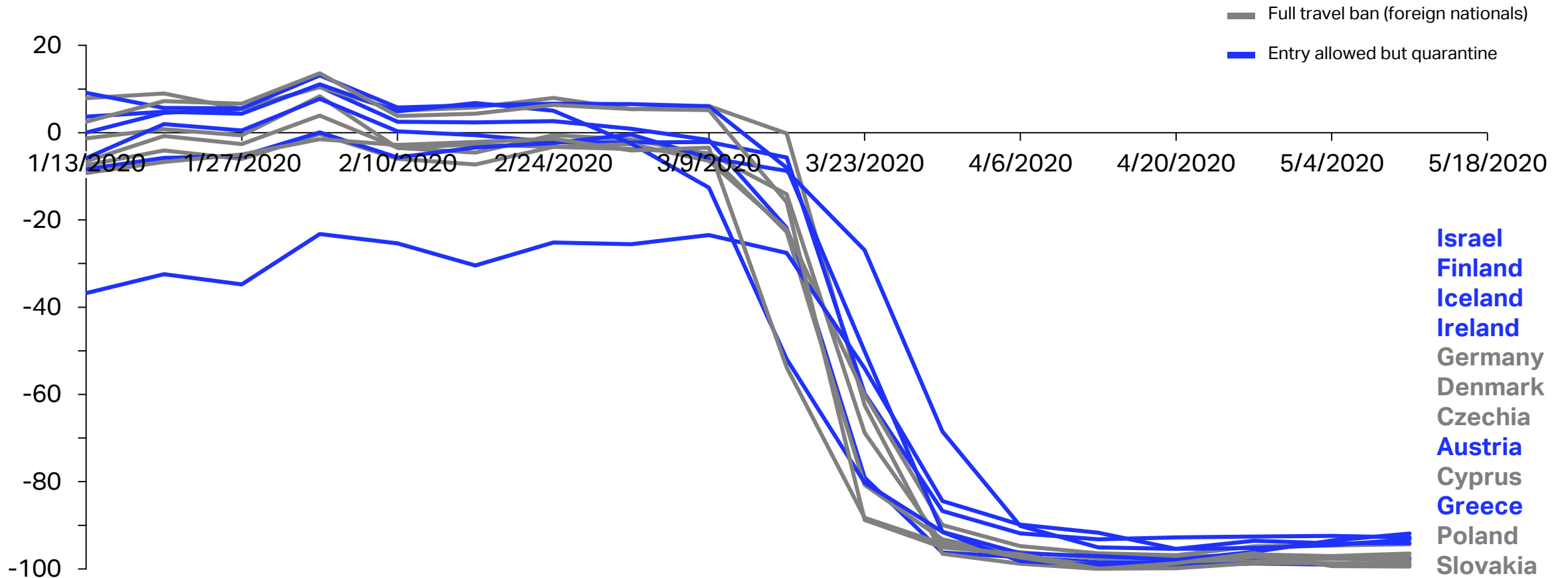

YoY change in flights by country of destination (%)

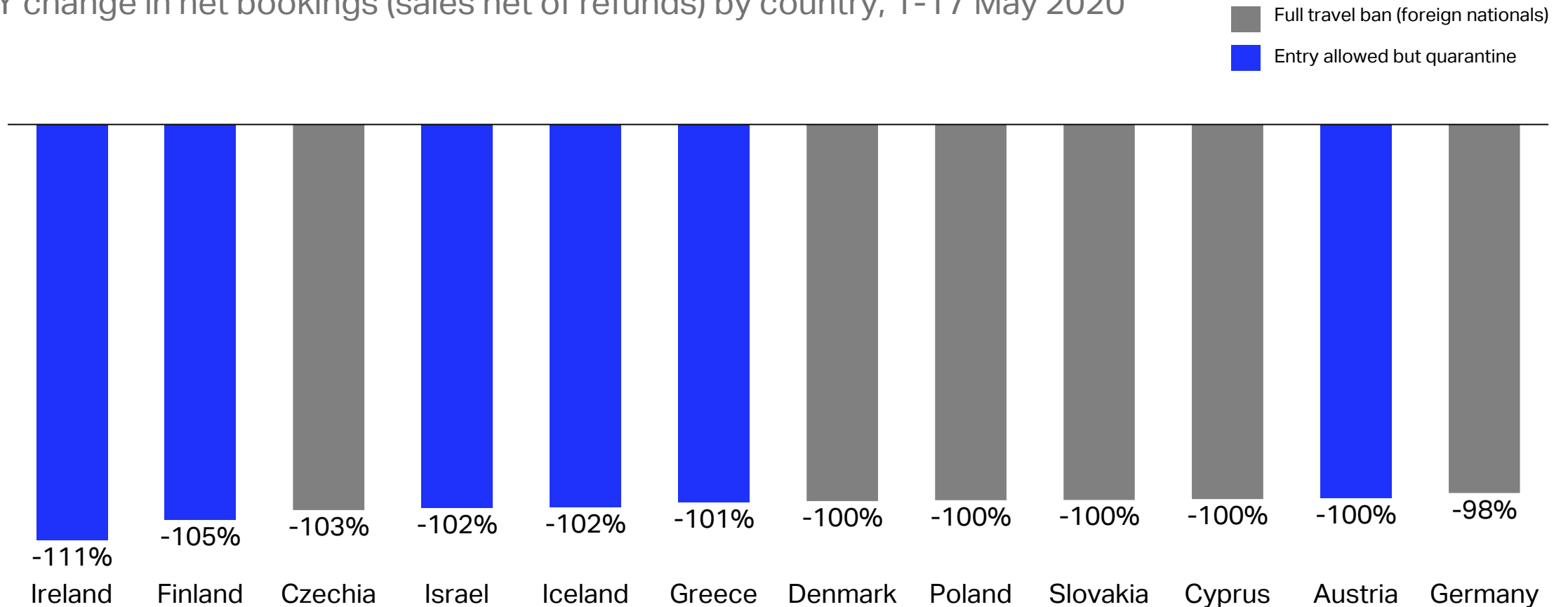

YoY change in net bookings (sales net of refunds) by country, 1-17 May 2020

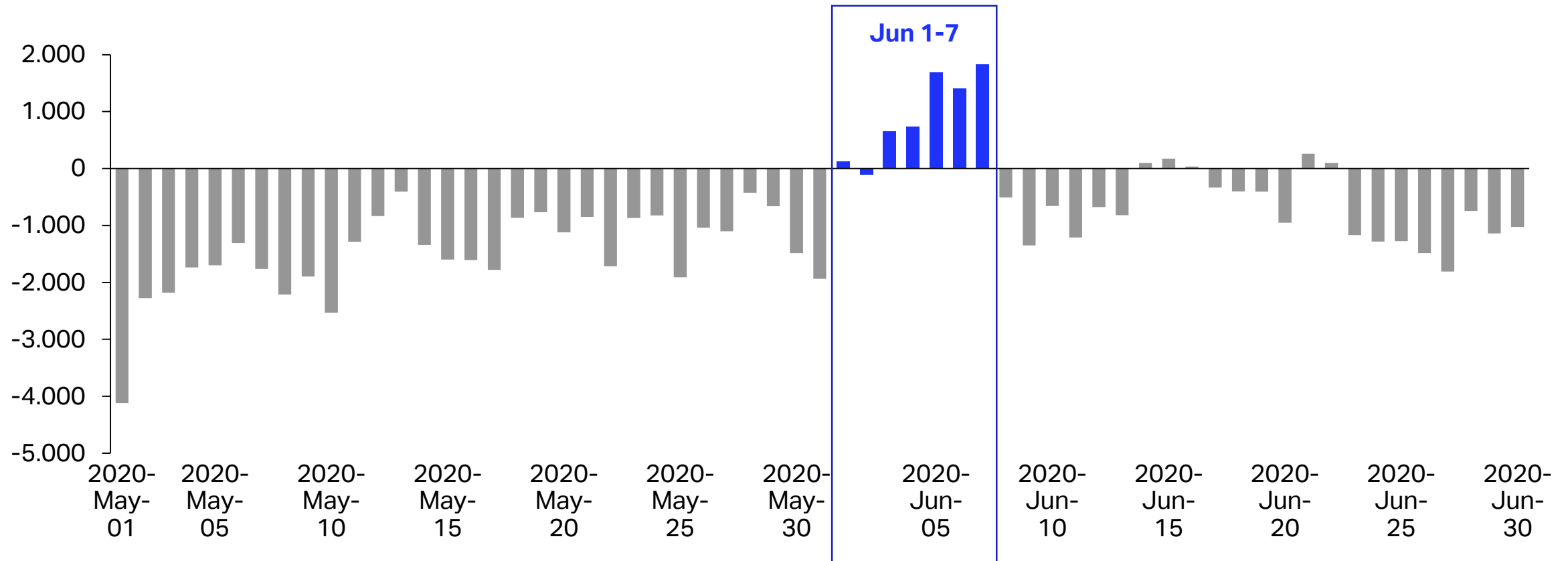
