PROGRAM FEES

The total fee of the program is USD7,650.

At the time of registration, you must commit to paying the fees for the entire program. The full fees may be paid in full upon your acceptance in the program or through a maximum of 2 instalments over the course of the 2 years of the program. Before attending a course, no instalment may be overdue.

Instalment payments may be made by credit card, bank transfer or through the IATA Clearing House. Payments by cheque or in cash cannot be accepted. If the transfer of an IATA Clearing House member fails to reach IATA within 45 days of service being rendered, IATA may charge that member via the Clearing House.

The complete payment of each instalment must be received 4 weeks prior to the beginning of the first course to be held for which the instalment payment is being made.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellation received by IATA more than 14 days prior to the commencement of the program: If you withdraw from the program more than 14 days prior to the commencement of the program (that is, when you are scheduled to take your first course), your payment will be fully refunded. The refund will be made using the same form of payment initially used.

Cancellation received by IATA 14 days or less prior to the commencement of the program: If you withdraw from the program 14 days or less prior to the commencement of the program (that is, when you are scheduled to take your first course), the payment received, minus a non-refundable administrative charge of USD \$500, will be refunded. The refund will be made using the same form of payment initially used.

Cancellation received after the commencement of the program: If you withdraw from the program after its commencement (that is, after the commencement of the first course you are scheduled to take), the amounts received, minus a non-refundable administrative charge of USD500, will be refunded on a pro-rata basis, with you receiving a refund of the amounts applicable to the courses paid for but not yet commenced. The refund will be made using the same form of payment.

Cancellation of a course made by IATA: IATA and Carleton University reserve the right to cancel any course up to 14 days prior to the course commencement. In case of cancellation, you will be allowed to register for the next same available course or select another course. IATA and Carleton University will not be liable for any expenses incurred by the participant up until the date of cancellation.
